ACT

To authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to the services for the year ending on thirty first day of March, 2019

Be it enacted in the Sixty ninth year of the Republic of India by the Uttarakhand State Legislative Assembly as follows-

Short Title	1- This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation (Supplementary 2018-2019) Act, 2018.
Issue of Rs. 24524125000 out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand for the year 2018-2019	2- From and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in colum-3 of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs 24524125000 (Rs Two Thousand Four Hundred Fifty Two Crore Forty One Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only) towards defraying the several charges, which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2019 in respect of the services and purposes specified in colum-2 of the Schedule.
Appropriation	3- The sums, authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes, expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2019.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

ARTICLE 204 of the Constitution read with ARTICLE 205 requires that an Appropriation Bill should be introduced in the State Legislature after the demands for Supplementary Grants have been voted by the Legislative Assembly.

This bill provides for the appropriation from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand of all moneys required to meet the Supplementary Grants made as approved by the Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly and expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State in respect of Financial Year 2018-2019.
