# THE UTTARAKHAND APPROPRIATION (VOTES ON ACCOUNT)

ACT, 2022

(Act No. 04 of 2022)

Act

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State to the service of the financial year 2022 -23

Be it enacted by the Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly in the Seventy Third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation (VOTES ON ACCOUNT) Act, 2022.

Issue of Rs.211168144000 out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand for the financial year 2022-23

### Appropriation

- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand, there may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in Column-8 and 10 for Voted and column-9 and 11 for Charged of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs 211168144000 (Rs. Twenty One Thousand One Hundred Sixteen Crore Eighty One Lakh Forty Four Thousand Only) towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment for services and specified in column 2 of said Schedule during the financial year ending on the thirty first day of March 2023.
- The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

## **OBJECTS AND REASONS**

Article 204 of the Constitution of India requires that an Appropriation Bill should be introduced in the State Legislative Assembly after the demands for grants have been voted by the Legislative Assembly, for incurring miscellaneous expenditure by the State from the Consolidated Fund of the State. A provision is necessary for authorizing the payment and appropriation of certain amount, therefore;

This Bill provides for the appropriation from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand of all moneys required to meet the Grants made by the Uttarakhand Legislative Assembly and the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State in respect of the first four months of the Financial year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2023.
