# The Uttarakhand District Planning Committee (Amendment) Act, 2020 (Uttarakhand Act no. 26 of 2020)

AN

Act

further to amend the Uttarakhand District Planning Committee Act, 2007;

Be it enacted by the Uttarakhand State Legislative Assembly in the Seventy-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- Short title and 1. (commencement
- (1) This Act may be called the Uttarakhand District Planning Committee (Amendment) Act, 2020.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Insertion of new 2, section 8-A

After section 8 of the Uttarakhand District Planning Committee Act, 2007, the following section shall be inserted, namely—

"8-A. Approval and application of District plan in inevitable circumstances:

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or any other Act when in opinion of the State Election Commission such emergency circumstances exist, that it is not feasible to conduct the election than, till such circumstances exist, proposed district plan after the approval of the State Government may be approved and applied in the concerned district by the District Magistrate of the concerned district."

## Repeal and saving 3.

- (1) The Uttarakhand District Planning Committee (Amendment) Ordinance, 2020 (Uttarakhand Ordinance No. 6 of 2020) is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of this Act.
