IT IS HEREBY enacted in the Sixty-Seven year of the Republic of India by the Uttarakhand State Legislative Assembly –

Short Title

1- This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation (First Supplementary 2016-2017) Act, 2016.

Issue of Rs.15078730000out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand for the year 2016-2017 2- From and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in colum-3 of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sums of Rs 15078730000 (Rs One Thousand Five Hundred Seven Crore Eighty Seven Lakhs Thirty Thousand only) towards defraying the several charges, which will come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2017 in respect of the services and purposes specified in colum-2 of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3- The sums authorized to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Uttarakhand by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes, expressed in the Schedule, in relation to the year ending on the thirty first day of March, 2017.
