NFS Delhi (e-PDS)

NFS is one of the important MMP to ensure food security for all in a scenario of self-sufficiency. It comprises of a network of 1990+ Fair Price Shops in 70 circles catering to an active base of 17.78+ lakh ration card holders having a combined base of 72.77+ lakh beneficiaries. Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act 1994 and Rule 1996 and as amended Rules 2014

- Filling of each column of form F for every ultrasound done on pregnant woman for every ultrasound done is absolutely essential along with declaration of pregnant women and doctor.
- Photo copies of completely filled form F's along with photo copies of referral slips are to be submitted to office of chief District Medical Officer by 5th of every following month.
- Issuing/ publishing/ distributing/communicating through any advertisement in any form regarding facilities of prenatal determination of sex or sex selection before conception in any manner is strictly prohibited under the Act.
- Application for renewal of registration certificate must be submitted 30 days before the date of expiry. A certificate is valid for five years.
- Display of the registration certificate at a conspicuous place in the registered centre is a mandatory requirement under the PC & PNDT Act.
- Every offence committed by the registered USG centre under the PCPNDT Act shall be cognizable, non-bailable and non-compoundable.
- Sale of equipments, capable of detecting sex, to unregistered centre is strictly prohibited under PC & PNDT Act and every sale and purchase of equipment capable of detecting sex should be intimated to concerned District Appropriate Authority as per PC & PNDT Act.
- All case related – records, forms of consent, laboratory results, microscopic pictures, sonographic plates or slides, charts, forms, reports and all the documents required to be maintained under this Act and the rules shall be preserved by the centers for a period of two years from the date of completion of counseling, pre-natal diagnostic procedure or pre-natal diagnostic test, as the case may be. In the event of any legal proceedings, the records shall be preserved till the final disposal of legal proceeding, or till the expiry of the said period of two years, whichever is later.
- In case the centers maintains records on computer or other electronic equipment, a printed copy of the record shall be taken and preserved after authentication by a person responsible for such record.

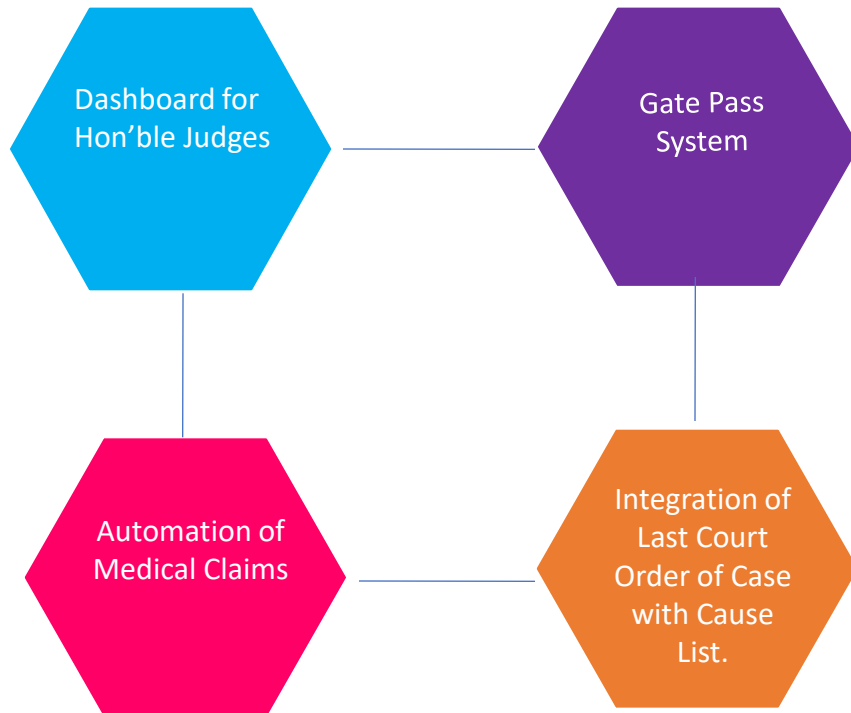

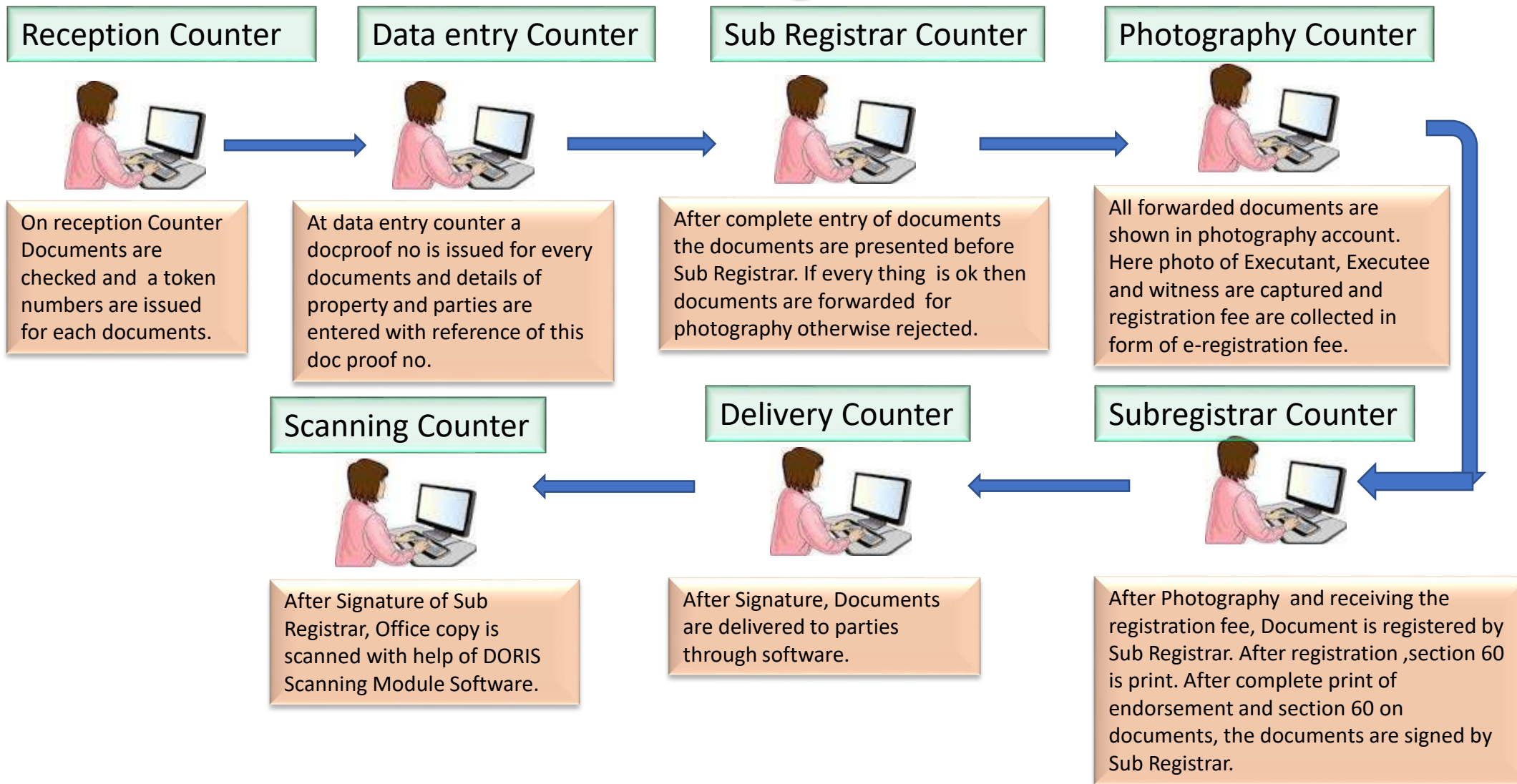

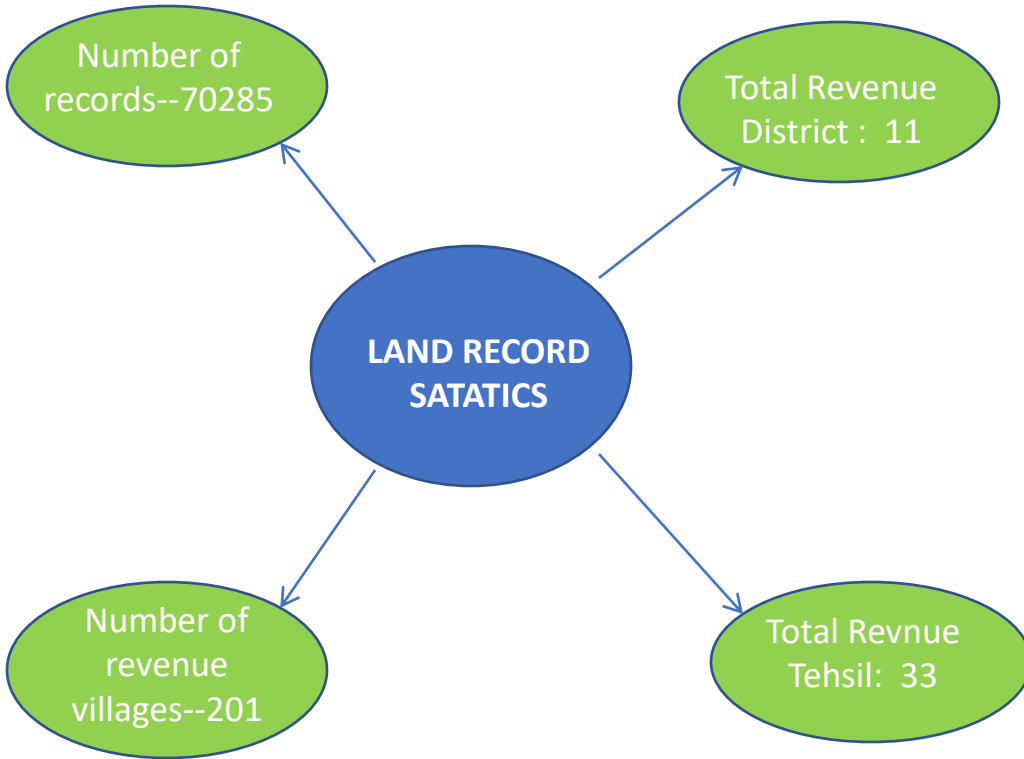
Through this application different departments apply to higher paneled advocated for any type of court cases.

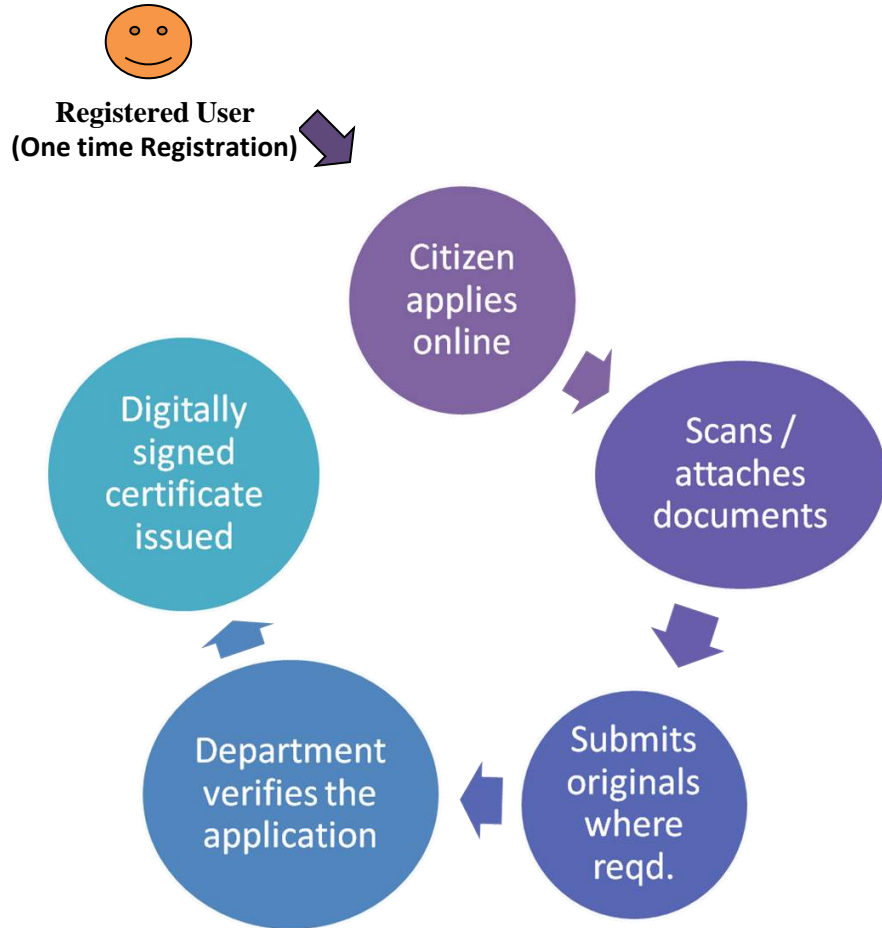

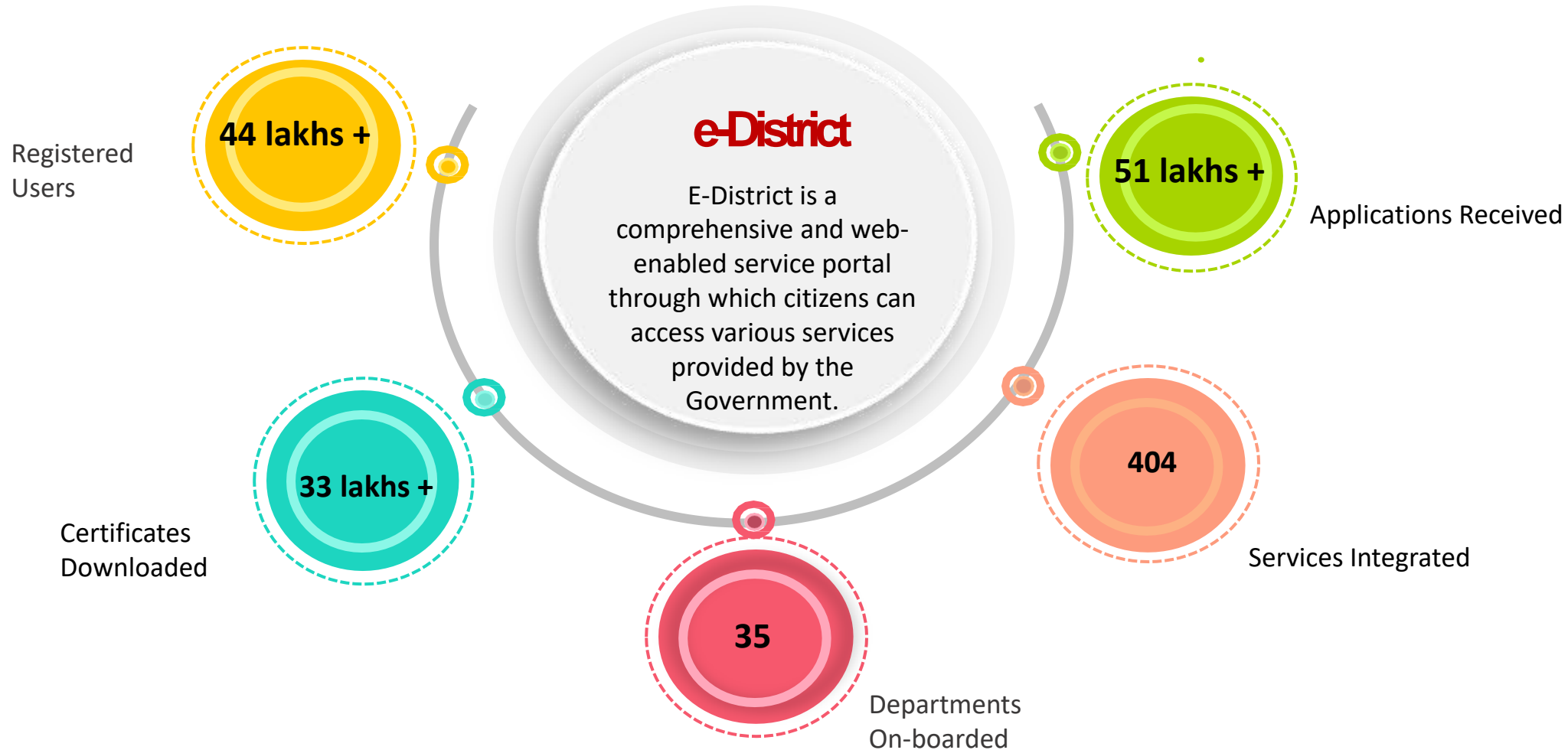

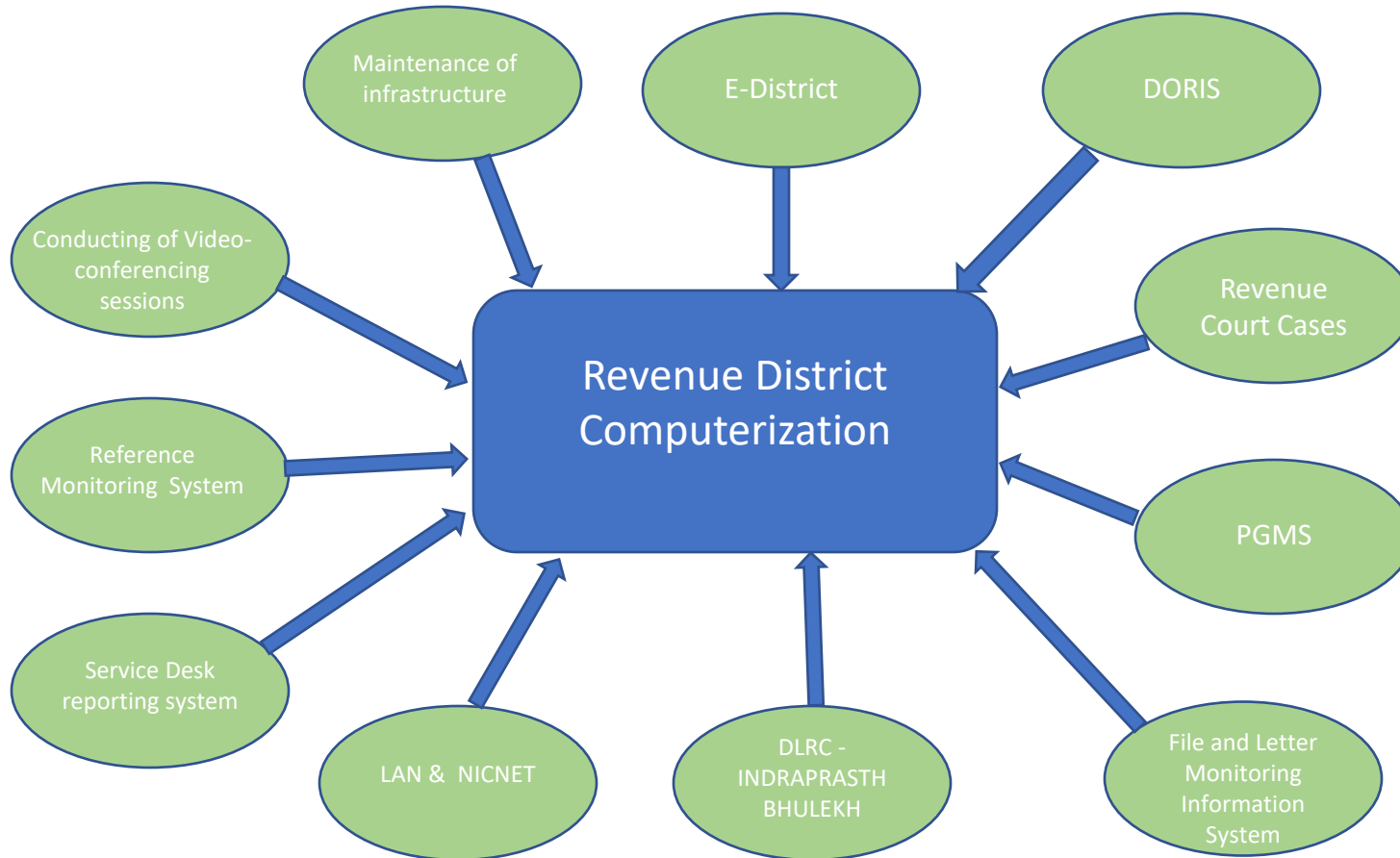

Certified copies of Registered Properties

On B Book portal public can create user id and apply for Certified copy of registered documents with online payment of ₹ 10 per page. After successful fee deposition a fee receipt is generated. After complete payment Certified copy is issued from Sub Registrar office with printed details.

Inspection of registered properties

For inspection of registered property, ₹ 100 per year is paid online or in concerned Sub Registrar Office. Inspection is done online or in concerned Sub Registrar office.

Apply for NOC

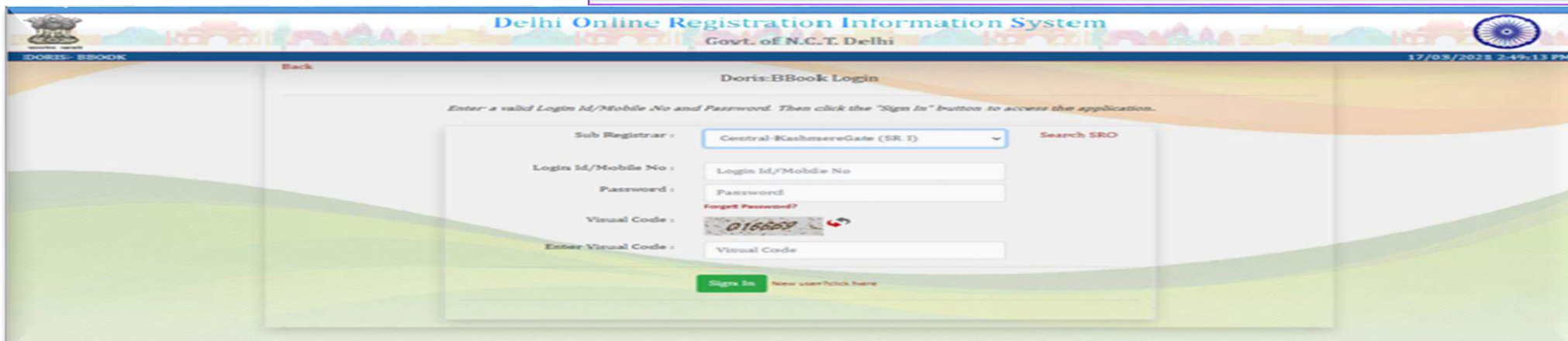
For Registration of Agriculture Land a NOC is required by LAC Department. Hence before registration of Agriculture property an application is applied paying Rs. 100 per application for NOC.

Apply for Home presentation

If a person want to register a document in Sub Registrar office but due to some genuine Problem he can not come to office then he can apply for home presentation paying ₹ 500 Plus ₹ 10 per km of going and coming distance from residence of applicant.

Document Custody Fee

If public do not collect their documents within a week after registration from Sub Registrar office then a custody charge is paid ₹ 50 per week and maximum ₹ 500.

Online Application and Registration System (OARS) is a web based system which was developed for Delhi Subordinate Services Selection Board (DSSSB) for receiving online applications for recruitments to the various posts advertised by the Board. The System receives applications online including Photograph, signature and relevant documents. Admit Cards are generated online and results also published online.

The system was conceptualized by keeping in mind the dynamism and variability of various recruitment rules and to impose them while accepting the online applications for various posts.
