CRC Sikkim celebrates International Day of Elderly Persons with various initiatives

GANGTOK, November 4

(PIB): The Composite Regional Centre (CRC) for Skill Development, Rehabilitation, and Empowerment of Persons with Disability, Sikkim, established in 2020 at Assam Lingzey, Pakyong District, under the aegis of the National Institute of Locomotor Disabilities (NILD), Kolkata, and the Department for Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (DEPwD), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, celebrated International Day of Elderly Persons.

To mark the occasion, CRC Sikkim distributed assistive devices to 63 elderly persons under the Rashtriya Vayask Yojna of PMDK (DIVYASA Kendra) in a series of programmes organized throughout the month of October.

The distributions were conducted through center-based walk-in assessments and outreach programs in various parts of the state, facilitated by ASHA workers and the health department.

On the way to fulfilling its objective of reaching the unreached, CRC Sikkim camped at the Health and Wellness Centre, Salgari, Namchi District, which is around 74 km from Gangtok, and participated at medical camps organized by the Department of Health in places



like District Hospital, Singtam.

The director of CRC Sikkim, along with other officials, delivered presentations and demonstrations, sensitizing the ASHA workers on disability and schemes of DEPwD at their monthly meeting at Old STNM Hospital, Gangtok, with the support of the National Urban Health Mission.

In a first-of-its kind endeavour, the CRC Sikkim started the National Board of Examination Rehabilitation (NBER) and Rehabilitation Council of India (RCI)-regulated Diploma in Sign Language Interpreter (DISLI) Course with 7 students at its center this month. The center also provided special education services to students with disabilities during the month.

The other schemes that the center has been implementing are the Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme for Persons with Cerebral Palsy, Autism,

Multiple Disabilities, and Intellectual Disabilities and UDID.

A webinar on the topic 'Cross Linguistic Teaching Method for Persons with Specific Learning Disabilities' with the participants of 'Purple Talks' NIEPMD, Chennai was organized with the support of Secretary School Education Govt. of Sikkim on October 3. Approximately 100 beneficiaries from 30 schools in Gangtok District, Sikkim, participated.
