## CRITERIA FOR B.ARCH. ADMISSION A.Y. 2024-2025

- Relaxation in Eligibility criteria as per the Amendment of CoA dated: 08.07.2024:
  - A candidate shall have passed the Qualifying Examination with minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed by Council of Architecture (CoA) stated as below,
- "No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with at least 45% (40% for SC, ST, SEBC and EWS candidates) marks in aggregate or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 45% (40% for SC, ST, SEBC and EWS candidates) marks in aggregate."

have qualified an aptitude test in architecture conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture of corresponding academic year."
