Offline Vacant Seat Round for Government and Grant-in-Aid Institutes for MPharm Courses for Admission Year: 2026–27

The online admission process for **First Year M.Pharm Courses for the academic year 2026–27** was completed on **25.08.2026**. Thereafter, the remaining vacant seats are to be filled as per the “Vacant Seats” provisions under the Master of Engineering and Technology and Master of Pharmacy Course(Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules.

Accordingly, the **Offline Vacant Seat Round** admission process for the First-Year Master of Pharmacy Courses of the Government and Grant-in-Aid institutions of the State under the Directorate of Technical Education will be conducted as per the schedule given below for the seats arising due to non-reporting, non-allotment and cancellation of admission at the institute level.

All candidates included in the First Year M.Pharm Admission 2026–27 merit list will be eligible to participate in this admission process. In line with provision of prevailing rule 20 (1) (ii), and as notified earlier, all aspiring candidates who have passed qualifying exam (BPharm) with minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in rule 5 of prevailing admission notification, but have neither qualified GPAT nor appeared in Common Entrance Test (PGCET 2026) conducted by ACPC for the current year and if they are willing to secure admission on vacant seats arising after online admission process of M.Pharm program in following courses/specialization at Government/Grant-In-aid institutes for academic year 2026-27 are also eligible to apply as per following instructions and timeline.

Moreover, in case candidate secures admission in vacant seats admission process, the process for refund of fee for seat already allotted by this committee during online admission process, shall be as per rule 19 of prevailing notification of Government of Gujarat for admission to M. E./M. Tech./M.Pharm courses

Steps/Instructions of Participation in above stated admission process

1. Candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria as mentioned in rule 5 pursuant to rule 20 (1) of admission notification for admission to MPharm courses shall have to fill the Google form available on the link: <https://forms.gle/Mxs8sSQF5ssVEPCdA> during **11/09/2026 to 3:00 PM on 13/09/2026** to become eligible for participation in this round. **The form will not accept response thereafter.**
2. The candidate has also to fill the application form available as **Annexure-I** of this document and **bring the duly filled form along with self-attested copies** of documents as mentioned in the application form at the time of counselling personally at ACPC, Ahmedabad.
3. The candidates shall have to bring **token tuition fees of Rs. 1500/- and Rs. 1000/- (in cash only)** towards non-refundable fee for registration along with the above mentioned application form and copies of requisite documents, original documents at the time of counselling personally at ACPC, Ahmedabad.
4. The detailed schedule and merit list shall be uploaded on committee's website <https://acpc.gujarat.gov.in/mpfarm-courses> tentatively on **18/09/2026, 5PM**
5. Since this admission procedure is on vacant seats as per prevailing rule 20 (1) (i) and (ii) of the admission notification, the merit list of candidates who have cleared qualifying exam with minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in rule 5 but have neither qualified GPAT nor appeared in Common Entrance Test (PGCET 2026) conducted by ACPC shall be prepared on the basis of percentage of marks obtained at qualifying examination, giving priority to candidates having ACPC merit.
6. There is no other means of registering/applying for the candidature for this round of admission on vacant seats, **thus candidates who fail to fill the Google form as stated above within prescribed time limit shall not be allowed to participate in this round of admission.**
7. The candidates are advised to read carefully important instructions/guidelines before applying and filling the Google form (All available on committee's website). However in case of a candidate applying without being eligible, or incomplete form filling, his/her application will be summarily

rejected and his application fee will be forfeited. No correspondence will be entertained in this matter.

8. The details of vacant seats are as stated above, the Eligibility criteria, Notifications for rules of admission to M.Pharm courses and other relevant details are available on committee's website.
9. The admission shall be subject to availability of Seats in the concerned course and institute at the time of counseling and fulfilling of all eligibility requirements as per prevailing admission rules of Govt. of Gujarat for M.Pharm Courses.
10. The candidates who are in merit list of ACPC can also participate in the above stated vacant seat admission process.
11.
