ATOMIC ENERGY GENERATION TARGET

321. SMT. PRIYANKA CHATURVEDI:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has achieved its atomic energy generation target set for the current year, so far;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the future targets of Government in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR.JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) The target set for the current year 2021-22 is 41821 Million Units. The target for the period April to June 2021 was 10164 Million units against which, the actual generation was 11256 Million Units.
- (c) The targets for nuclear power generation are set on an annual basis, as a part of Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL)'s annual Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Department of Atomic Energy (DAE). The targets for future will be set on an annual basis prior to the commencement of the financial year.
