Sub: Contributory Health Service Scheme of DAE -Applicability to retired employees of the Department of Space on reciprocal basis amendment thereto.

The question of extension of the CHSS facilities of the Department to the retired employees of the Department of Space on a reciprocal basis who are presently residing at Bombay, TAPS (Tarapur), RAPS (Kota), HWPs (Talcher) has been under consideration of the Department.
