Subject: Extension of CHSS facilities to the retired employees of DOS/ISRO under reciprocal arrangement at Pune.

The undersigned is directed to state that the question of extending the Contributory Health Services Scheme (CHSS) to the retired employees of DOS/ISRO under reciprocal arrangement at Pune, has been considered in consultation with NCRA, TIFR, Pune.

2. The proposal for extending medical facilities to DOS retirees at NCRA, Pune is approved in the Department subject to the following Conditions:

- (i) The number of families availing CHSS facilities at Pune would be restricted to 25 to begin with. The DOS retirees should reside at Pune which means that the area recognised as a part of Pune for payment of HRA at Pune city rates and should have documentary proof such as ration card etc./ for support of their claim.
- (ii) All cases of retired employees of DOS/ISRO, who wish to avail CHSS facility at Pune through NCRA, will be referred to DAE by the respective DOS/ISRO Centre directly.

 (iii) Expenditure towards extension of medical facilities to the retired employees of DOS/ISRO as above would be settled by DOS.
