RECRUITMENT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions of article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director (OL), Department of Atomic Energy, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement : (1) These rules shall be called the Department of Atomic Energy Assistant Director (OL) Recruitment Rules, 1961.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay : The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc. : The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (1) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification: No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and that other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax : Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions, required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

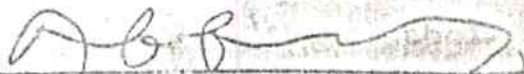

G.S.R.:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Department of Atomic Energy, Assistant Director (Official Language), Recruitment Rules, 1991, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement :-

(1) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy [Assistant Director (Official Language)] Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1996.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment to the Schedule :-

In the Schedule to the Department of Atomic Energy, Assistant Director (Official Language) Recruitment Rules, 1991, (i) in column 11, for the entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

"By promotion, failing which by deputation and failing both by direct recruitment" ;

(ii) in column 12, under the sub-heading Promotion, after note 2, the following note shall be added, namely :-

"3. Where the juniors who have completed their qualifying eligibility service are being considered, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying eligibility service by more than one year and have successfully completed their probation, if prescribed" ; and

(iii) in column 13 for the entries, the following entries shall be substituted, namely :-

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Reference is invited to DAE Notification No.20/1(2)/89-CCS/1231 dated December 10, 1991 read with DAE Notification No.20/1(2)/89-CCS/8 dated 28.2.96 regarding Recruitment Rules for the post of Assistant Director (Official Language).

The question of providing certain percentage of posts in the grade of Assistant Director (Official Language) to be filled up on seniority-cum-fitness basis has been under consideration in this Department. It has now been decided that with immediate effect 20% posts in the grade of Assistant Director (Official Language) will be filled up on the basis of seniority-cum-fitness from among the Senior-Hindi Translators (Scale of pay of Rs.5500-175-0000) who have completed 8 years of regular service in the grade.

Action is being initiated to incorporate the norms in the RR under Article 309 of the constitution which will be notified in due course.
