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In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Secretary in the Department of Atomic Energy, namely:-

- .1. Short title and commencement:
 - (a) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy (Deputy Secretary) Recruitment Rules, 1988.
 - [b] They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- Number of posts, classification and scale of pay: The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule is annexed to these rules.

- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc:
 The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit,
 qualifications and other matters connected therewith
 shall be as specififed in columns 5 to 14 of the said
 Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification: No person:-

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[a] who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

[b] who, having a spouse living, has entered into or

- contracted a marriage with a person
 shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:
 provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied
 that such marriage is permissible under the personal
 law applicable to such person and the other party to
 the marriage and that there are other grounds for so
 doing, exempt any person from the operation of this
 rule.
- 5. <u>Power to relax</u>: Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. <u>Saving</u>: Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations i relaxation of age limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Department of Atomic Energy, (Deputy Secretary) Recruitment Rules, 1988 namely:-

- 1. 1) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy (Deputy Secretary) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1991.
- 2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In the Schedule to the Department of Atomic Energy (Deputy Secretary) Recruitment Rules, 1988 in column 12, for item (a) and entries relating there to the following entries shall be substituted, namely:

"a) Transfer on deputation:

From among the officers of the Centralised Administrative/Accounts Cadres in the grade of Rs.3700-125-4700-150-5000 or 3 years of regular service in the grade of

Rs.3000-100-3500-125-5000 or 5 years of regular service in the grade of Rs.3000-100-3500-125-4500".

- NOTE: 1) The period of deputation shall not exceed 4 years"
 - 2) The principal rules where notified vide G.S.R.675 dated 20.8.1988 at pages 2572 to 2575 of the Gazette of India, Part-II, Section 3,Subsection (i).

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:

Norms for the post of Deputy Secretary to the Government of India in the Department of Atomic

Energy (Scale of pay Rs. 12000-16500).

Reference is invited to this Department's notification of even number/ 650 dated 14.06.1988, read with Notification No.1235 dated 10.12.1991, regarding the Recruiment Rules for the post of Deputy Secretary to the Government of India in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs3700-5000 (revised scale Rs.12000-16500) in the Department.

2. In column 11 of the Schedule to the said Recruitment Rules, the method of recruitment of the post has been indicated as 50% by transfer on deputation of the Departmental Officers and 50% by transfer on deputation of other officers. On a review of the said Recruitment Rules and considering all relevant aspects, it has been decided to modify the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Secretary as follows:

"1/3rd (one-third) of the posts by transfer on deputation of the Departmental Officers and 2/3rd (two-third) by transfer on deputation of other officers." i.e. suitable officers from the All India Services and other organised services under Central Staffing Scheme as per recommendations of Department of Personnel and Training in accordance with relevant instructions of the Central Govt. on the subject.

3. Action to incorporate necessary amendment in the existing RRs and to notify the same under Article 309 of the Constitution is being taken separately. This order, issued with the approval of the Competent Authority, will come into force with immediate effect.
