NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Hindi Translator in the Department of Atomic Energy, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement : (1) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy Senior Hindi Translator Recruitment Rules, 1991.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Number of post, classification and scale of pay : The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.
The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

Disqualifications: No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and that other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax: Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving : Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions, required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

1. Promotion

Junior Hindi Translators in the scale of Rs.1400-40-1800-EB-50-2300 who have put in a minimum regular service of 5 years in the grade.

NOTE: 1. When Departmental Promotion Committee meets before the 1st July, the relevant date for the purpose of eligibility will be 1st January and when it meets after 1st July, the relevant date will be 1st July of the calendar year.

2. The selection will be made after interviewing the eligible candidates.

2. Deputation

Eligible officers, either from Kendriya Sachivalaya Raj Bhasha Seva of the Government of India or from any other Central Government Department/ or State Governments holding the analogous or equivalent post or with a minimum service of 5 years as Junior Hindi Translator in the scale of Rs.1400-40-1800-EB-50-2300.

3. Representative of the concerned unit -Member

4. A member from another Constituent unit of appropriate level -Member

G.S.R.:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 308 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Department of Atomic Energy, Senior Hindi Translator Recruitment Rules, 1991, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement :-

(1) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy (Senior Hindi Translator) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 1996.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Department of Atomic Energy Senior Hindi Translator Recruitment Rules, 1991, -

(i) in column 11, for the entry, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :-

"By promotion, failing which by deputation and failing both by direct recruitment";

(ii) in column 12, under the sub-heading Promotion, after note 2, the following note shall be added, namely :-

.... /

3. Where juniors who have completed their qualifying eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying eligibility service by more than one year and have successfully completed their probation, if prescribed."
