**NOTIFICATION**

G.S.R. : In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Joint Director (Official Language) in the Department of Atomic Energy, Mumbai namely :-

1. **Short title and commencement :-** (1) These rules may be called the Department of Atomic Energy (Joint Director (Official Language)) Recruitment Rules, 2001.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay :-** The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc. :-** The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said schedule.
  
4. **Disqualification :-** No person,- (a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ; or (b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax :-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

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6. Saving : - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions, required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Class, the Ex-Serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Deputation :-**

Officers of the Central Government or State Government or All India Services or Central Civil Services -

- a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis, or (ii) with 5 years regular service as Deputy Director or Senior Hindi Officer or Hindi Officer in the pay scale of Rs.10000-325-15200.
- b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience :
- (i) Master's degree of a recognised University or equivalent in Hindi with English as a subject at the degree level ;

OR

Master's degree of a recognised University or equivalent in English with Hindi as a subject at the degree level ;

Master's degree of a recognised University or equivalent in any subject with Hindi medium and English as a subject at the degree level ;

OR

Master's degree of a recognised University or equivalent in any subject with English medium and Hindi as a subject at the degree level ;

- (ii) 10 years experience of terminological work in Hindi or translation work from English to Hindi and vice-versa preferably of technical & scientific literature ;  
10 years experience of teaching, research, writing or journalism in Hindi.

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


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Note :-

The period of deputation/short term contract including the period of deputation/short term contract in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/ Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years but may be extended by one more year by the Department of Atomic Energy.
