OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Withdrawal of Project Concessions in its entirety in the Department - regarding.

The Department vide three OM Nos.11/1(11)/71-PP(A), (B) and (C) all dated 16.11.1974 introduced "Project Concessions" comprising eleven concessions in the Department w.e.f. 01.11.1974. Subsequently, the Department vide OM No.2/33/97-SCS/1139 dated 30.11.1998, with the concurrence of Member(Finance), AEC reviewed the aforesaid eleven Project Concessions and reduced it to four Project Concessions. While communicating concurrence, Member(Finance), AEC advised the Department to review the withdrawal of four concessions in a phased manner. The Department vide OM No.2/1(4)/2010-SCS/Vol.II/4352 dated 28.03.2013, with the approval of Atomic Energy Commission, further reviewed the four Project Concessions and reduced it to three Project Concessions.

2. Presently, following three project concessions are in vogue in the Department:-
 - (a) Extension of free electricity concession in two slabs based on grade pay of 6th CPC.
 - (b) Transportation of school children by charging Rs.200/- per month per child.
 - (c) Providing departmental bus for the excursion of school children for not more than four times in a year upto a distance of 100 km each way @ Rs.46/- per km.
3. A Committee was constituted for examining the issue of continuation of these three Project Concessions or otherwise, post 7th CPC. The Committee examined the issue and observed that in 1974, most of the amenities were not available at Project sites hence Project concessions were extended to the Units. However, at present, almost all amenities are available in all the sites and are also well accessible.

4. The observations/recommendations of the Committee have been examined in the Department and in supersession of all the Orders/guidelines on Project Concessions, it has been decided in the Department to withdraw the Project Concessions extended in the Constituent Units, Public Sector Undertakings and Aided Institutions, in its entirety with immediate effect. In the event of stoppage of such concessions in the Department, such concessions, if being extended to CISF personnel in DAE Units will also stand withdrawn.

5. Heads of all the Constituent Units, Public Sector Undertakings and Aided Institutions are requested to ensure adherence of the contents of the above OM and send a compliance report by 31.10.2022. In case, the Project Concessions were not in existence in a particular Unit/PSU/AI, a 'Nil' report may be furnished to this Department invariably.
