Ministry of Minority Affairs (MoMA) seeks to facilitate opportunities for minority and disadvantaged communities in the field of education, skilling, livelihood, and employment, to ensure their inclusive development in the national fabric. To this effect, the Ministry has launched a new, integrated scheme - 'Pradhan Mantri Virasat Ka Samvardhan (PM VIKAS)'.

The scheme targets 10 out of the 17 Sustainable DevelopmentGoals (SDGs), seeking to achieve inclusive and sustainable growth, by converging five existing livelihood and education schemes of the Ministry viz.
