OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Contributory Health Service Scheme.

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Attention is invited to para 15 of the Contributory Health Service Scheme of the Department regarding reimbursement of expenses incurred in a medical emergency (other than maternity) in Greater Bombay. The question of further liberalisation of the provisions of the scheme in this regard has been under consideration of the Department for quite some time. After careful consideration of the matter it has now been decided as under:

Room charges

Operation charges inclusive of anaesthesia & O.T. charges

Special Nursing charges

Fathology/ Radiology The restriction on reimbursement of accommodation charges to 60% of entitled charges in respect of non-panel hospitals will be dispensed with.

For all categories

Major operation: Actual charges subject to a ceiling of Rs.800/-

Minor operation. Actual charges subject to a ceiling of Rs.200/-

At present there are no provisions for reimbursement of special nursing charges. It has now been decided to reimburse these charges at the rate of Rs.40/- for day nurse and Rs.45/- for night nurse provided the treating Doctor certifies this to be essential.

Reimbursement will be allowed as per para 15.13.6 without any restrictions on the number of plate/exam. after scrutiny by Head, Medical Group.

The limit of liability of Government in each case of emergency treatment in private hospitals will be Rs.1500/instead of Rs.1000/- at present.
