
OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Contributory Health Service Scheme for  
Officers and staff of the DAE stationed  
at Bombay.

In Note (b) below Para 4.1 of the Contributory Health  
Service Scheme of the Department of Atomic Energy introduced vide  
U.M. No. 32/5/69-Adm. dated April 21, 1975, it has been laid  
down that parents who normally reside with the employee and whose  
total monthly income does not exceed the pay of the employee and  
is not more than Rs. 350/- p.m. are regarded as wholly dependent  
on the employee and are eligible for CHS benefits. It has been  
decided to raise the monetary limit of Rs. 350/- p.m. regarding  
monthly income of parents to Rs. 500/- p.m. with immediate effect  
for determining the eligibility of parents for CHS benefits  
under the Scheme.
