Progress of Cancer Hospital in Muzaffarpur, Bihar

1284 # Shri Sushil Kumar Modi:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- a) the funds that have been approved for the Cancer Hospital in Muzaffarpur, Bihar along with the amount that has been released so far and the physical and financial progress of the construction work;
- b) the departments that have been opened temporarily at present;
- c) the number of patients being treated every month and the plans for the future, the details thereof; and
- d) the date by which the hospital will be ready?

ANSWER

AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH)

- a) The funds that have been approved for the Cancer Hospital in Muzaffarpur in Bihar is Rs.198.15 Cr. and the amount released so far is Rs.77.47 Cr. The Physical Progress and the Financial Progress is 35% and 37.58% respectively for the construction work as on October 2023.
- b) Administrative Department comprising of Medical & General administration, HRD, Accounts, IT, Engineering, Stores & Purchase, Security & Fire; Clinical Departments comprising of Preventive Oncology, Medical Oncology, Pediatric Oncology, Head & Neck Oncology, Breast & Gastro-intestinal Oncology, Gynaec Oncology, Anesthesiology and Laboratories for Histopathology, Cytopathology, Haematopathology, Biochemistry, Microbiology have been opened temporarily for functioning of the hospital.
- c) Approximately 1400 patients are treated every month for Chemotherapy and approximately 60 Major Surgeries and 130 Minor Surgeries are performed.

Commissioning of Radiotherapy services, upgradation of medical & surgical facilities and establishing residential facilities for employees are some of the future plans.

- d) The hospital is expected to be ready by 31.03.2026
