- (a) At present pre-project activities are underway at Mahi Banswara Rajasthan Atomic Power Project (4 X 700 MW). The land for the project is acquired and various site investigations have been initiated. R&R award is announced and amount is deposited by NPCIL with state authorities. Construction of R&R colony is completed. Activities for obtaining environmental clearance from MoEF&CC and siting consent from Atomic Energy Regulatory Board (AERB) are at various stages. Procurement of long delivery equipment has also been initiated.
- (b) The cumulative expenditure on the project up to November 2023 is Rs. 636 crore.
