REPRESENTATION FROM OFFICERS OF NPCIL

649. DR. SUBRAMANIAN SWAMY:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Nuclear Power Corporation Officers' Association has made numerous representation to Government regarding grant of pensionary and terminal benefits as per CCS(Pension) Rules 1972 to the officers of the Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd. (NPCIL);
- (b) if so, the nature of these representations;
- (c) whether these representations have been considered by Government and hearing granted to the Association; and
- (d) the details of Governments response to the points/issues raised by the Association?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (Dr. JITENDRA SINGH):

(a)&(b) Yes, Sir. The Nuclear Power Corporation Officers Association (NPCOA) has submitted a representation requesting grant of pensionary and terminal benefits as per CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.

CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 apply to Government servants and do not apply to Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) employees.

(c)&(d) The representation has been forwarded to Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL), a Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) of the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE) advising them to examine the issue and send suitable reply directly to the NPCOA. In the meantime, Nuclear Power Corporation Officers Association has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Bombay in this regard.
