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**Department of Atomic Energy working towards clean and green future  
through the initiatives undertaken in Special Campaign 5.0**

Department of Atomic Energy has set up targets for Special Campaign 5.0. Initiatives and tasks are being undertaken by the Department and its Constituent Units/PSUs/AIs to ensure that the targets are completed by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2025. The Department shall review 14520 files during the Campaign period, out of which as on 17.10.2025, 4728 files have been reviewed, 3613 files have been identified for weeding and 2633 files have been weeded out. Also 169 cleanliness campaigns shall be conducted by the Department and its Constituent Units/PSUs/AIs. As on 17.10.2025, 47 cleanliness campaigns have been conducted. Department aims to complete the targets during the month long campaign.

Saha Institute of Nuclear Physics (SINP), Kolkata, an Aided Institution under the Department, undertook an initiative to make the society clean and green, which has been successfully executed with team work. SINP, in consultation with Bidhannagar Municipality have cleaned huge amount of leftovers in a closed Municipal vat adjacent to residential campus of SINP, Meghnad Saha Abasan-I and handed over the wastes to Municipal compactor machine for proper recycling and disposal. The area was sanitized and saplings were planted, involving local residents, shop owners and nearby office representatives. Awareness posters have been displayed to prohibit further dumping of garbage which is a necessity for maintaining proper hygiene and a sustainable environment.
