CIRCULAR

Sub : Validity of prescription for purchase of medicine.

A question regarding the validity of the prescription issued by Medical Officers to patients for purchase of medicines and claim reimbursement, if the particular medicine is not available in the Pharmacy, was under consideration for some time.

It has now been decided that when a particular medicine is not available in the pharmacy and the Medical Officer issues prescription for purchase and claim, such prescription will be valid only for one month from the date of issue i.e. the recommended medicines should be purchased within one month from the date of issue of the prescription. All CHSS beneficiaries are requested to note the above.

This will be effective from the date of issue of the circular.
