We had released Rs. 150 lakh first installment to NJA, Bhopla during first quarter ( April-June,2020) Current Financial year vide our sanction order dated 18.05.2020. Other request of the Academy, Rs. 300 lakh has also been released to NJA, Bhopal for the second quarter ( July-September,2020) which were disbursed in three installments during during July, August and September Rs. 100.00 lakh in each month i.e. second, third and fourth installments. National Judicial Academy, Bhopla has requested for release of funds of Rs. 300.00 lakh, but IFD only concurred 100.00 lakh to the month of October, 2020 as fifth instalment and 200.00 lakh as sixth installation to the month of November and December, 2020. NJA has submitted of Utilization Certificate towards sixth instalment of **Grant-in-Aid (Non-Plan) of Rs. 100.00 ( Out of Rs. 200.00 Lacs.)**

National Judicial Academy, Bhopal furnished a letter and requested to release of 250.00 lakh as Revenue of Grant-in-Aid (General-Non-Plan) for 2020-21. Since Budget Estimates for 2020-21 for the " Revenue Grant-in-Aid (General)" is Rs.10.00 crore, and 1.00 crore allocated to the Swachatta Action Plan. As per the Ministry of Finance Guidelines a Office Memorandum No. 12(13)-B(W&M)/2020 dated 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2020 and **clearly noted that the monthly expenditure may be kept at 5% each of BE 2020-2021 during First Quarter.**

Out of these 10 crore, Rs. 7.5 crore has been released up to October, 2020.
