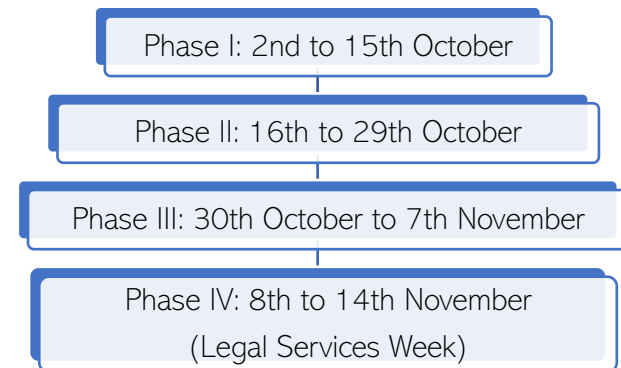
Pan India Outreach Campaign

Due to the magnitude of the Campaign, it had been divided in four phases.

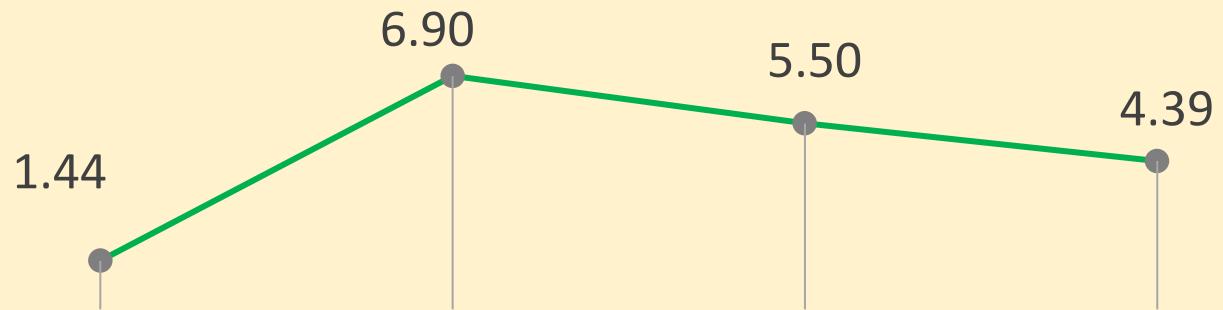




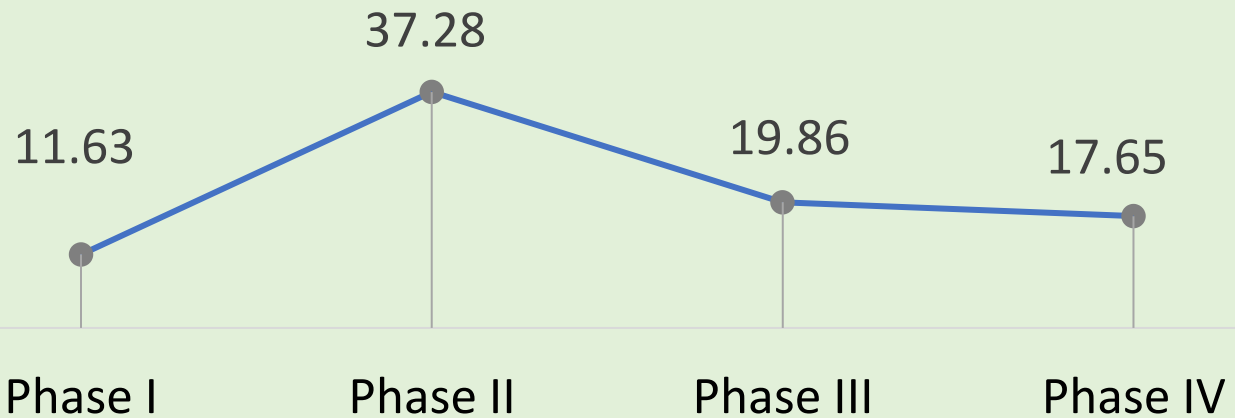
