Prime Minister's Housing Scheme Rural (PMAY-G)

Details

Launched on April 2016, Prime Minister Awas Yojana Rural (PMay-G) is the head of the Center by the Ministry of Rural Development (MOHUA) by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Transaction (MOHUA). The goal of the PMay-G is to provide all homeless families and to the families living in the raw and dilapidated homes with basic amenities. PMay-G runs away the shortcomings of rural homes and compensates for the lack of homes in rural areas of India, contributing significantly to the "homes for all". The minimum size of homes under PMay-G is 25 square meters that include a dedicated area for hygienic cooking. As of September 27, 2022, 2.00 crore houses have been built out of 2.72 crore targets. The beneficiaries are identified using social-economic and racism parameters and verified by the Gram Sabha. The amount is transferred directly to the beneficiary's Aadhaar-Link Bank account / Post-Office account. The PMay-G has been extended for two more years, ie March 3124.

Benefits

- Financial assistance per unit for flat parts Rs.1,20,000; And for mountainous areas, difficult areas and IAP districts (the Himalayan states, the northeastern states and the union territories of Jammu and Kashmir). Rs.1,30,000 per unit
- The minimum size of the house should be 25 square meters that have a dedicated area for cleaning cooking.
- In the consolidation of Swachh Bharat Mission-Rural (SBM-), beneficiaries get financial assistance of up to Rs. 12,000 to build toilets.
- In convergence with MGNREGA, the beneficiary is eligible for employment for 95.95 per 95 days as unskilled workers (rural village training).
- In adapting the Prime Minister Ujjwala scheme, an LPG connection per house is provided.
- Consolidation of various government programs for drinking water, electricity connection, clean and efficient cooking fuel, social and liquid waste processing etc.
- Payment is done directly electronically in bank accounts or post office accounts connected to Aadhaar.

Qualification

- The universe of eligible beneficiaries under PMay-G will include all the homeless families living in zero walls and raw roofs with raw walls and raw roofs (according to SCC data, and subject to the process of excluding).
- Criteria for automatic/mandatory inclusion -
- Homes with no shelter
- To live on destitute/ begging

- Manual Scavenger
- The primitive tribal group
- Legal release of a binding laborer.
- In the state of Maharashtra, at least 15 years should be 15 years.
- The land of self or government is required.
- There should be no home of yourself or family.
- Widowed abandoned, destitute, remote areas priority to beneficiaries.
- The annual income limit of the applicant's family is Rs.1 lakh.
- The beneficiaries should be beyond the criteria of the Social, Economic and Caste Survey 2011 (SEC-2011) Priority List.
- Grants will remain as per PMayg (120000 12000- (SBM) MGNREGA-20000)
- 1.30 attention to Naxalite/hilly beneficiaries.
- Construction of households in the 269 sq ft mat area.

Application process

The beneficiaries have four sections of the registration process:

Personal details, bank account details, convergence details and details of the relevant office.

To successfully add registration or beneficiary, follow the following steps:

- Visit the official website to login PMay.
- Fill the required details in the personal detail section (such as gender, mobile number, Aadhaar number, etc.)
- Upload the consent form required to use the Aadhaar number.
- Click on the search button for the beneficiary's name, PMay ID and preference.
- Click on "Select to Register".
- The beneficiary details will be automatically generated and displayed.
- The remaining beneficiary details can now be filled, such as the type of ownership, relationship, Aadhaar number, etc.
- Upload the consent form required for the use of the Aadhaar number on behalf of the beneficiary
- In the next section, add the beneficiary account details to the required field, such as the beneficiary's name, bank account number, etc.
- If the beneficiary wants to borrow, select "Yes" and enter the required loan amount.
- In the next section, enter the MNREGA Job Card number of the beneficiary and the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) number.
- The next section will be filled by the concerned office.

Ramai Awas Gharkul Plan: (State Scheme)

Eligibility of Beneficiaries:

1. Scheduled castes should be in category.
2. In the state of Maharashtra, at least 15 years should be 15 years.
3. The land of self or government is required.
4. There should be no home of yourself or family.
5. Widowed abandoned, destitute, remote areas priority to beneficiaries.
6. The annual income limit of the applicant's family is Rs.1 lakh.
7. The beneficiaries should be beyond the criteria of the Social, Economic and Caste Survey 2011 (SEC-2011) Priority List.
8. Grants will remain as per PMayg (120000 12000- (SBM) MGNREGA-20000)
9. 1.30 attention to Naxalite/hilly beneficiaries.
10. Construction of households in the 269 sq ft mat area.
11. There is a committee for the selection of beneficiaries and the Chief Executive Officer is the Chairman and Assistant Commissioner, Social Welfare is the Member Secretary.

Shabari Housing Scheme: (State Scheme)

Eligibility of Beneficiaries:

- For the Scheduled Tribes (ST) components in the state.
- In the state of Maharashtra, at least 15 years should be 15 years.
- The land of self or government is required.
- There should be no home of yourself or family.
- Widowed abandoned, destitute, remote areas priority to beneficiaries.
- The annual income limit of the applicant's family is Rs.1 lakh.
- Grants will remain as per PMayg (120000 12000- (SBM) MGNREGA-20000)
- 1.30 attention to Naxalite/hilly beneficiaries.
- Construction of houses in the area of 269 sq ft.

Modi Awas Gharkul Yojana: (State Scheme)

Eligibility of Beneficiaries:

- This scheme is for the beneficiaries of other backward classes and special backward classes.
- In the state of Maharashtra, at least 15 years should be 15 years.
- The land of self or government is required.
- There should be no home of yourself or family.
- Widowed abandoned, destitute, remote areas priority to beneficiaries.
- The annual income limit of the applicant's family is Rs.1 lakh.
- Grants will remain as per PMayg (120000 12000- (SBM) MGNREGA-20000)
- 1.30 attention to Naxalite/hilly beneficiaries.
- Construction of houses in the area of 269 sq ft.

Yashwantrao Chavan Free Settlement Scheme

Eligibility of Beneficiaries:

- Under this scheme, only 1049 houses in Jalgaon district have been approved for the beneficiaries of the Vimukta castes and wandering tribes.
- For this, the Gharkul Committee is chaired by the Collector and the beneficiaries of the committee will be allowed to the beneficiaries who are eligible.
- The caste certificate, income certificate, habitat certificate and non -profit beneficiaries will be eligible for this. A scrutiny committee will be conducted in this regard. Assistant Commissioner of Social Welfare will be the Member Secretary for this.
- This scheme is only for Ahmednagar, Dhule and Jalgaon districts.

Prime Minister Tribal Justice Maha Abhian (PM Janman): Adim Housing Scheme-

Qualification of Qualification:

- Survey the beneficiaries of Katakari/ Madiya Gond/ Kolam etc. (PVTG) and selecting the eligible families and giving them the benefit of the Gharkul Yojana.
- The beneficiary should not have a permanent home.
- Members of the families of the beneficiaries should not be in government service.
- Grants (200000 12000-(SBM) MGNREGA-27000 total of Rs 2.39 lakh)
- Construction of houses in the area of 269 sq ft.

Atal Construction Workers Housing Scheme (Rural):

- Gharkul scheme for construction workers in rural areas.
- Construction Workers Welfare Board should be registered as a construction worker for more than one year in a row.
- The beneficiary should not have a permanent home.
- Members of the families of the beneficiaries should not be in government service.
- District level beneficiary selection committee under the chairmanship of Additional Labor Commissioner/Labor Deputy Commissioner to scrutinize applications. Deputy District Executive Officer, Maharashtra Building and other Construction Workers Welfare Board is the Member Secretary.
- Grants will remain as per PMayg (120000 12000- (SBM) MGNREGA-20000)
- Construction of households in the 269 sq ft mat area.

Punyashlok Ahilabai Holkar Yojana:

- Wandering tribes - Beneficiary of Dhangar community in the category.
- The committee is chaired by the District Collector and the Member Secretary is Assistant Commissioner Social Welfare.
- The beneficiary should not have a permanent home.
- Members of the families of the beneficiaries should not be in government service.
- Grants will remain as per PMayg (120000 12000- (SBM) mgnrega- 20000)
- Construction of houses in the area of 269 sq ft.
