NOTICE ON REPORTING RULES FOR ROUND-2

The final result of Round 2 of AACCC-PG Counseling- 2024 has been uploaded on the AACCC-PG portal (https://aaccc.gov.in/) on **09.10.2024**. Before proceeding for admission, candidates are instructed to download the "**Provisional Allotment Letter**" from the AACCC-PG portal. Further, it is requested to strictly adhere to the Counseling Schedule as mentioned below:

	Rules for Round-2 joined candidates: Candidates joined the R-2 allotted/upgraded seat and do not wish to retain the joined R-2 seat; in that case	➤ Candidate can Exit the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees till 5:00 PM of 14.10.2024 (i.e. till 3 days prior to commencement of R-3). Such candidates are eligible for AACCC-PG/ State-UT Counseling. Further, they can participate in subsequent rounds of AACCC-PG counseling as per the eligibility criteria fixed for that round by filling in fresh choices and need to pay complete counselling fees again for registration. Candidate can exit the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from 15.10.2024 to 05:00 PM of 23.10.2024. [i.e., the period from 3 days before the commencement of R-3 to the date of announcement of R-3 final result (excluding the final result date)]; however, such candidates will be eligible for State/UT counseling but ineligible for further rounds of AACCC-PG Counseling. Candidates can exit the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from 24.10.2024 (the date of announcement of R-3 final result); however, such candidates will become ineligible for AACCC-PG will become ineligible for AACCC-PG counseling will become ineligible for AACCC-PG

Candidates can Exit from the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees till 14.10.2024 (i.e. till 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3). Such candidates are eligible for AACCC-PG Counseling / State-UT Counseling. Further, they can

participate in subsequent rounds of AACCC-PG counseling as per the eligibility criteria fixed for that round by filling fresh choices and need to pay complete counselling fees again for registration.

- Candidates can exit from the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from 15.10.2024 to 05:00 PM of 23.10.2024 [i.e. the period of 3 days before the commencement of R-3 and till the date of announcement of R-3 final result final (excluding the result date)]; however, such candidates will be eligible for State/UT counseling but ineligible for **further AACCC-PG** rounds of Counseling.
- Candidate can exit the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from 24.10.2024 (the date of announcement of R-3 final result); however, such candidates will become ineligible for AACCC-PG Counseling and State-UT Counseling.

NOTE

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college through online mode only by generating the "Provisional Admission Letter" from the AACCC PG portal. Any admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.
- Candidates are also advised to ensure that their seats "Withdrawal/Surrender letters" are generated ONLINE through the AACCC-PG portal by the allotted institutes.
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
