Notice on Reporting rules for Round-3

The final result of Round 3 of AACCC-UG Counseling-2024 has been uploaded on the AACCC-UG portal (<https://aaccc.gov.in/>). Before proceeding for admission, candidates are instructed to download the “**Provisional Allotment Letter**” from the AACCC-UG portal. Further, it is requested to strictly adhere to the Counseling Schedule as mentioned below

	The candidate has been allotted/upgraded to a seat in R-3 of AACCC-UG Counseling but also holding a seat allotted through State/UT Ayush Counseling.	Must join the R-3 allotted/upgraded course/college through AACCC-UG Counseling as per schedule, and the admitted seat/previous allotted/ seat allotted after R-3 result through any rounds of State/UT counseling, if any, shall stand cancelled.
If allotted / upgraded	<u>Rule for R-3 Joined candidates:</u> If a candidate is upgraded/ allotted a seat in the R-3	Must join the R-3 allotted/upgraded college through AACCC-UG Counseling as per schedule. Further, they are not allowed to withdraw/surrender their admitted seats; if they do so, they will become ineligible for all Ayush-UG Counseling (Central/State/UT) with forfeiture of counseling fees for the A.Y 2024-25.
If not upgraded	R-1/R-2 admitted candidates if not upgraded during R-3	Candidate will be treated as R-3 admitted candidate from the date of announcement of R-3 final result and Rules of R-3 joined candidates will be applicable to them.
	Candidates whose seats have not been upgraded from R-1/R-2 to R-3	Continue their study at the joined R-1/R-2 institute. If the candidates withdraw the R-1/R-2 seats from the announcement of the R-

		3 final result (17.10.2024), they become ineligible for all Ayush- UG Counseling (Central/State/UT) with forfeiture of counseling fees.
If not allotted	Wish to participate in the next rounds of AACCC-UG counseling.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Candidates can participate in the Stray Vacancy Round by filling fresh choices in SVR-I. ➤ Registered candidates who opt for '<i>Deemed University</i>' in the '<i>selection of counseling</i>' on the portal till 3rd Round and wish to be admitted to the Deemed University, in that case, they can participate in the SVR-DU. ➤ Registered candidates who did not opt for '<i>Deemed University</i>' in the '<i>selection of counseling</i>' on the portal till 3rd Round and wish to be admitted to the Deemed University, in that case, they can participate in the SVR-DU by opting for '<i>Deemed University</i>' in the '<i>selection of counselling</i>' on the AACCC-UG portal during SVR-I.

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college through online mode only by generating the “**Provisional Admission Letter**” from the AACCC UG portal. Any admission made through **OFFLINE MODE** shall be treated as **null & void**.
- Candidates are also advised to ensure that their seat “Relieving letters” are generated online through the AACCC-UG portal by the previously joined institutes.
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
