Salient features of Stray Vacancy Round for AIQ seats under Govt./Govt. Aided/CU/NI/Deemed Universities

First allotment phase (SVR-I)- for AIQ seats of Govt./Govt. Aided/CU/NI	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ Registration & Choice filling available➤ No upgradation available from previous rounds
The vacant/ not reported/withdrawn seats available after the reporting period of SVR-I will be considered during the second allotment for those candidates who have not been allotted any seats through SVR-I. The second allotment will be purely based on the choices locked by the candidates/locked as per server time during the choice-filling period of the First allotment phase- SVR I.	
Second allotment phase (SVR-II)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ No Registration available.➤ No Choice filling available.
Stray Vacancy Round for Deemed Universities (SVR-DU)	No separate Registration Facility is available for candidates who are seeking admission to Deemed Universities. Registration is common for all Govt./ Govt.-aided/CU/NI/Deemed Institutes. Registered candidates who opted 'Deemed University' as 'selection of counseling' on the AACCC-PG portal during R-1, R-2, R-3 and SVR-I and not holding any seats that get allotted through any rounds of AACCC-PG/State/UT counseling can participate in SVR-DU
NOTE: Non-registered candidates who wish to participate in SVR-DU are advised to register themselves on the AACCC portal during the First allotment phase (SVR-I)

NOTE: Eligible candidates who wish to participate in SVR-I & II need to make a calculative decision before participating, as once they are allotted a seat in SVR-I & II of AACCC-PG Counseling, they must join the SVR-I & II allotted institute and their admitted seat / earlier allotted/ seat allotted after SVR-I or SVR-II result through any rounds of State/UT-Ayush PG Counseling 2024, if any, shall stand cancelled.

Eligibility Criteria For candidates participating in the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I&II) for AIQ seats under Govt./Govt. Aided / Central Universities/National Institutes	
1.	Only AIAPGET-2024 qualified candidates who have registered in the 1 st /2 nd / 3 rd Round of AACCC-PG counseling are eligible to participate, provided that,- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Candidates who have not been admitted to any of the seats through 1st and 2nd rounds AACCC-PG counseling or counseling conducted by State/UTs ii. Candidates who have not been allotted any seats through 3rd round AACCC-PG counseling
2.	Candidates who have not registered in the AACCC-PG counseling and have not been admitted to any of the seats through State/UTs counseling are eligible to participate after registering on the AACCC-PG Portal during SVR-I.
3.	Round-1 non-joined/joined candidate who availed of Free Exit.
5.	Round-1 admitted candidates who did not get an upgrade during R-2/not participated in R-2 and availed of exit with forfeiture till 14.10.2024 can participate with full payment of counselling fees.
6.	Round-2 non-joined candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture of counselling fees can participate with full payment of counselling fees.
7.	Round 2 admitted/upgraded candidates who availed of exit with forfeiture of counseling fees till 14.10.2024 can participate with full payment of counseling fees
Note: The candidates whose names are reflected in the ineligible list published on the AACCC-PG portal on 24.10.2024 are ineligible to participate in the SVR-I &II	

Stray Vacancy Round (SVR) for AIQ seats under Deemed Universities

As per the AACCC-PG counseling scheme 2024, AACCC, M/o Ayush will forward the list of registered eligible and ineligible candidates to the respective Deemed Universities for smooth counseling & admission process in the online Stray Vacancy round (SVR-DU) through the AACCC-PG portal. Only registered candidates who opt for '**Deemed Universities**' in the '**Selection of Counseling**' on the AACCC-PG portal are eligible for the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-DU) and **not registered** in the AACCC-PG counseling are **not eligible** to participate in the SVR-DU. Therefore, candidates who registered for the AACCC-PG counseling and wish to take admission in the seats under Deemed Universities are advised to contact the respective Deemed Universities to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-DU).
