## NOTICE

The final result of Stray Vacancy Round/SVR-I (Govt./Govt. Aided/CU-NI) of AACCC-PG Counseling- 2024 has been uploaded on the AACCC-PG portal (<https://aacc.gov.in/>). Before proceeding for admission, candidates are instructed to download the “**Provisional Allotment Letter**” from the AACCC-PG portal. Further, it is requested to strictly adhere to the Counseling Schedule as mentioned below

<b>Approved Admission Rules for Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I)</b>		
Condition I	Candidates who have been allotted seats during Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I)	<b>Must join</b> the allotted seat as per schedule; otherwise, ineligible for any Ayush-PG Counseling 2024 (Central/State-UT) with forfeiture of counseling fees.
Condition II	If a Candidate has been allotted a seat through SVR-I of AACCC-PG Counseling by submitting the <b>false undertaking</b> on the portal stating that, <i>‘he/she is not holding any seat allotted through Central/State/UT Counseling rounds’</i> .	In that case, the candidate <b>must join</b> the course/college allotted through AACCC-PG Counseling as per schedule. The seat held by the candidates, allotted through any State/UT Counseling rounds, if any, shall stand cancelled.
Condition III	Candidates who have not been allotted seats during SVR-I	Wait for the <b>final result of the SVR-II</b> . If the name is reflected in the SVR-II result, the candidate must join the allotted course/college; otherwise, they will be ineligible for any Central/State/UT Ayush-PG Counseling with forfeiture of counseling fees.

## **NOTE**

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted

college through **ONLINE MODE** only by generating the “**Provisional Admission Letter**” from the AACCC PG portal. **Any admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.**

- Candidates are informed that there is **NO PROVISION FOR SURRENDER / WITHDRAWAL** of the seat allotted through the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I)
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
