As the State/UT counseling for admission to ASU&H-UG and PG courses is concerned it is noticed that few colleges are participating in the ongoing State/UT counselling process based on interim orders issued by various Hon'ble High Courts across the country. In this case, the students' future is at stake until the Court's final decision. In such cases, if the decision is against the candidates, the colleges, counselling authorities, and Universities cannot re-instate the candidate to the college to continue their studies.

In view this, the competent Authority of Ministry of Ayush has decided to issue advisory to all State/UT counseling Authorities regarding submission of a notarized affidavit cum undertaking by the guardian of the student to the college and also by the Principal of the college to the State/UT counseling Authorities. Sir/Madam,

As per the approved schedule issued by the NCISM/NCH, Central/State/UT counselling Authorities are conducting counselling for admission to UG&PG courses under ASU&H streams for the A.Y 2024-25. As per the directives issued by the NCISM/NCH regarding the Central/State/UT counselling 2024, the colleges/Institutes who have received permission from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM)/National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH) for UG&PG courses under Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy streams for the academic session 2024-25 shall only be eligible to participate in the counselling process.

- 2. In this regard, it has come to the Ministry's notice that few colleges are participating in the ongoing State/UT counselling process based on interim orders issued by various High Courts across the country. Needless to say that the affiliating/examining University shall not allow these students to appear in the examinations, as it might be the case that the final verdict of the Court litigation is awaited during the examination schedule. As the Ministry is dealing with such similar issues to those of previous years' students, it has been noticed that the students' future is at stake until the final decision of the Court. In such cases, the colleges, counseling authorities, and Universities cannot re-instate the candidate to the college to continue their studies. Further, in case the final outcome of the Court is against the candidate/college, candidates shall lose their precious time to grab other career opportunities also.
- 3. Therefore, in view of the above facts and in exercise of the powers as conferred under Section 44 of NCISM & NCH Act, 2020, the State/UT counselling Authorities are directed to ensure the following instructions:
 - i. All Private ASU&H institutions have to display the permission status of the college for the A.Y 2024-25 issued by NCISM/NCH on the college's website; they should also display the number of seats obtained through the interim order on the official website along with case detail and latest update of case time to time.
 - ii. At the time of allotment, all counselling authorities are instructed to mention the permission status of the college against the available seat matrix of the college and display the same on the counselling authorities' website.

- iv. Before initiating the allotment process, thoroughly verify the consent of affiliation of the University to which the colleges are affiliated.
- v. Ensure that the candidates are well aware of the permission status of the allotted college, in case it is through interim orders. Further, during the reporting time, the college shall convey to the candidate that his/her admission through interim orders is only provisional and subject to the final outcome of the court order.
- vi. Further, the Principal of the college shall submit Affidavit-cum-Undertaking to the State/UT Counseling Authority in the case where admission is based on seat/permission obtained by an interim order of the Court. (Annexure-I)
- vii. In the case where admission is based on seat/permission obtained by interim order, the State/UT Counseling Authority shall ensure that the college has taken Affidavit-cum-Undertaking from the candidate during the admission process. (*Annexure-II*)
- 4. Considering the candidates' future, All State/UT counseling authorities are instructed to strictly enforce these advisories for the smooth conduction of counseling for admission to UG&PG courses under ASU&H streams for the A.Y 2024-25.
