The final result of Stray Vacancy Round -SVR-II (Govt./Govt. Aided/CU-NI) of AACCC-PG Counseling- 2024 has been uploaded on the AACCC-PG portal (<https://aacc.gov.in/>). Before proceeding for admission, candidates are instructed to download the “**Provisional Allotment Letter**” from the AACCC-PG portal. Further, it is requested to strictly adhere to the Counseling Schedule as mentioned below:

Approved Admission Rules for Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II)		
Condition I	Candidates who have been allotted seats during the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II)	MUST join the allotted seat as per schedule; otherwise, ineligible for any Ayush-PG Counseling 2024 (Central/State-UT) with forfeiture of counseling fees.
Condition II	If a Candidate has been allotted a seat through SVR-II of AACCC-PG Counseling by submitting the wrong undertaking on the portal stating that, ‘ <i>he/she is not holding any seat through Central /State/UT Counseling rounds</i> ’.	In that case, the candidate MUST join the course/college allotted through AACCC-PG Counseling as per schedule. The seat holding by the candidates, allotted through any State/UT Counseling rounds, if any, shall stand cancelled.

NOTE

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college through **ONLINE MODE** only by generating the “**Provisional Admission Letter**” from the AACCC PG portal. **Any admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.**
- The candidates whose name reflected on the Ineligible list published on the 21.11.2024 on the AACCC-PG portal are not allowed to participate in any further AYUSH-PG counseling (Central/State/UT) 2024.
- If a candidate gets allotted seat in SVR-II, then his/her earlier allotted seat /admitted seat /allotted seat after SVR-II final result through Central/State/UT counseling, whichever applicable, stands shall have cancelled.
- Candidates are informed that there is **NO PROVISION FOR SURRENDER / WITHDRAWAL** of the seat allotted through the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-II)
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.
