The final result of Round 2 of AACCC-PG Counseling- 2025 has been uploaded on the AACCC-PG portal (<https://aaccc.gov.in/pg-counselling/>) on **09.10.2025**. Before proceeding for admission, candidates are instructed to download “**Provisional Allotment Letter**” from the AACCC-PG portal. Further, it is requested to strictly adhere with the Counseling Schedule as mentioned below:

(need to pay complete counseling fees again) Further, candidates must obtain online generated relieving letter (<i>for future reference</i>) and original documents from the previous R-1 joined institute.
	<u>Rules for Round-2 joined candidates:</u> Candidates joined the R-2 allotted/upgraded seat and do not wish to retain the joined R-2 seat.	Can exit the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to commencement of R-3; (eligible for AACCC-PG/ State-UT Counseling). Further, such candidates can participate in subsequent rounds of AACCC-PG counseling as per the eligibility criteria fixed for that round by filling in fresh choices. (need to pay complete counseling fees again) Candidates who exits the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees between the period of 3 days before the commencement of R-3 and till the date of announcement of R-3 final result (<i>excluding the final result date</i>) will be eligible for State/UT counseling but ineligible for further rounds of AACCC-PG Counseling. Candidates who exit the R-2 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from the date of announcement of R-3 final result; such candidates will become ineligible for

		AACCC-PG counseling / State-UT Counseling.
If not upgraded	R-1 admitted candidates if not upgraded during R-2	Candidate will be treated as R-2 admitted candidate from the date of announcement of R-2 final result, and <i>Rules of R-2 joined candidates will be applicable to them.</i>
	Candidates whose seats have not been upgraded from R-1 to R-2 and wish to retain the R-1 joined seat	Candidates are advised not to fill fresh choices during R-3.
	Not upgraded R-1 candidates who hold R-1 seats and want to upgrade their seats during R-3	Candidates can participate in the R- 3 by filling fresh choices.
	Candidates whose seats have not been upgraded from R-1 to R-2 and do not wish to retain the R-1 joined seat.	R-1 admitted candidates whose seats have not been upgraded in R-2 shall be treated as joined candidate of R-2 from the date of announcement of the R-2 final result, and R-2 rules apply for them. Candidates can exit the R-1 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees 3 days prior to the commencement of R-3. (Such candidates are eligible for AACCC-PG Counseling / State-UT Counseling). They can participate in subsequent rounds of AACCC-PG counseling as per the eligibility criteria fixed for that round by filling fresh choices. (need to pay complete counseling fees again) Candidates who exit the R-1 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees between the period of 3 days before the commencement of R-3 and till the date of announcement of R-3 final result

		(excluding the final result date) will be eligible for State/UT counseling but ineligible for AACCC-PG Counseling. Candidates who exits the R-1 admitted seat with forfeiture of counseling fees from the date of announcement of R-3 final result will be ineligible for AACCC-PG Counseling / State-UT Counseling.
If not allotted	Wish to participate in the next rounds of AACCC-PG counseling.	Candidates can participate in subsequent rounds of AACCC-PG counseling as per the eligibility criteria fixed for that round by filling fresh choices.

NOTE

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college through online mode only by generating the “**Provisional Admission Letter**” from the AACCC PG portal. Any **admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.**
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the **admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.**
