	If a Candidate has been allotted a seat through SVR-I/SVR-II of AACCC-PG Counseling by submitting the wrong undertaking on the portal stating that, ‘ he/she is not holding any seat through Central/State/UT) Counseling Rounds ’.	In that case, the candidate must join the course/college allotted through AACCC-PG Counseling as per schedule. The seat holding by the candidate, allotted through any State/UT Counseling, if any, shall stand cancelled.
