**GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING ONLINE PHYSICAL SPOT ROUND
FOR ADMISSION ON UNDER-GRADUATE AND POST-GRADUATE
SEATS UNDER DEEMED UNIVERSITY OF AYURVEDA, UNANI &
HOMOEOPATHY COURSES FOR THE A.Y. 2025-26**

INTRODUCTION

The Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), Ministry of Ayush conducts counseling for All India Quota (AIQ) seats of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani & Homoeopathy (ASU&H)-UG & PG courses of Government, Government Aided colleges, Central Universities/National Institutes/Deemed Universities for A.Y. 2025-26.

The role of AACCC is limited to the online allotment of seats to the eligible candidates, as per their merit and choice, which starts only after receiving the list/data/Information of qualified candidates from the National Testing Agency (NTA).

AACCC-UG/PG counseling Scheme for counseling & admission to Deemed Universities for the A.Y. 2025-26

As per the approved AACCC-UG/PG Counseling Scheme-2025, there will be only 1 online physical spot round of counseling for admission to seats under Deemed Universities.

After SVR-2, AACCC will forward the list of registered eligible and ineligible candidates to the respective Deemed Universities for smooth counseling & admission process in the online Physical Spot round through the AACCC-UG/PG portal. Only registered candidates who opt for '**Deemed Universities**' in the '**Selection of Counseling**' on the AACCC-UG/PG portal are eligible. The candidates who have **NOT REGISTERED** in the AACCC-UG/PG counseling are **NOT ELIGIBLE** to participate in this round conducted by Deemed Universities. The counseling and admission shall be strictly conducted by exercising in order of merit and preference of the candidates and shall not violate the Counseling directives issued by the NCISM/NCH in this regard.

All Deemed Universities are requested to go through the **list of candidates who are ineligible** to participate in the Ayush counseling published in the AACCC-UG/PG portal (<https://aaccg.gov.in>) before the allotment of seats to the NEET(UG)-2025/AIAPGET-2025 qualified candidates.

The Candidates are advised to check their eligibility before participating in the Online Physical Spot Round by visiting the Deemed University's website for the latest updates related to the round conducted by the concerned Deemed Universities.

The AACCC shall not be responsible for any allotment made by the Deemed University during Online Physical Spot Round in contravention to the eligibility and other relevant admission procedures laid down under NCISM/NCH Act, 2020. If any such activities noticed, strict action shall be initiated against the institution as per rules/Law.

Eligibility criteria for Candidates to participate in the Online Physical Spot Round of AACCC-UG/PG Counseling 2025

- Registered candidates who opted ‘**Deemed University**’ as ‘**selection of counseling**’ on the AACCC-UG/PG portal during **R-1, R-2, R-3 and SVR-I** and not holding any seat allotted during any rounds of AACCC/State/UT counseling **are eligible to** participate in Online Physical Spot Round .
- Candidates who have been admitted through any previous rounds of AACCC-UG/PG Counseling and State/UT counseling and in the final list of ineligible candidates published by AACCC on the portal are **not eligible to participate** in AACCC-UG/PG Counseling.

GENERAL GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED BY DEEMED UNIVERSITIES FOR CONDUCTING Online Physical Spot Round THROUGH AACCC-UG/PG PORTAL

1. The AACCC forwards the list of registered eligible candidates to the concerned Deemed Universities. Only those Candidates whose name is present in the eligibility list provided by AACCC shall be considered for the Online Physical Spot Round.
2. The Candidates must be given adequate time before the Online Physical Spot Round to make them aware of rules/regulations etc., before participating in the Online Physical Spot Round, i.e. the number of vacant seats and the fee structure should **be advertised well in advance** on the college website. The Colleges/Institutes should **widely publicize** the same.
3. Colleges/Institutes must display the eligibility conditions on their website well before the commencement of the Online Physical Spot Round to enable the participating candidates to make an informed decision.
4. **Candidates must be physically present** during admission/verification of documents at the Institutes. Any Authorized Person, in the absence of the candidate, **must not be entertained**.
5. The Institute’s Authorities must physically verify the entire candidate’s documents at the time of admission during Stray Vacancy Round. Deemed Universities are directed to ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing the admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained
6. The names/details of the admitted Candidates must be entered on the AACCC-UG/PG online


counselling portal by the College Authorities. The institutes must enter the candidates' data on the portal after verifying all the documents/details submitted by the candidates at the time of admission. Once the candidates' data is entered on the AACCC-UG/PG portal, **no alterations/changes** can be made through the reporting officer profile.

7. Universities must make the **allotment process transparent** with a proper record, documentation of the process followed and attendance recorded. The Colleges must **maintain the said record(s)** to enable the AACCC or any Authority to verify the details as and when required. If the **complaint of merit violation** during seat allotment is received against any Deemed University, and found true on verification; the **institute will be penalized** as per the provision laid down under the *sub-section (1)(a) and (f) of section 28; sub-section (3) of section 10 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act*, and the **persons responsible will be prosecuted** as per the section of **IPC/BNS** concerned.
8. The results of the Online Physical Spot Round must be displayed on the Institute's website.
9. No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission to UG and PG courses decided by NCISM/NCH. Therefore, all formalities related to admission shall be completed within the stipulated time mentioned by NCISM/NCH.
10. Admissions shall not be approved, by any means, after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.
11. No authority has the power to modify the intake capacity for admission into UG/PG courses in ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/MARBH /NCISM/NCH
12. AACCC will circulate the list of ineligible candidates to State/UT Ayush Counseling authorities, National Institutes/ Central Universities/ Deemed Universities to prohibit them from participating in further Ayush counseling. The University Authorities are also requested to ensure that such candidates have not been allotted any seat through the Online Physical Spot Round of counseling conducted by the Deemed Universities.
13. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling, and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.

14. Admission made in violation of the Central Government / NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act, 2020.

15. Any **Legal complication/enquiry** by any Authority due to **merit violation** or any mistake/default that occurred during the conduction of the Online Physical Spot Round shall be the **responsibility of the University**, and AACCC, NCISM/NCH shall not be held liable for the same.

16. Institutes will be held responsible if students face hardship due to admission irregularities (*offline admissions, admission without counseling and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity*). In such case, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be penalized as per the provision laid down under the *sub-section (1)(a) and (f) of section 28; sub-section (3) of section 10 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act*, and the *persons responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned*.



Deemed University Counseling Authorities are directed to ensure that the procedures of the Online Physical Spot Round should be as per the guidelines issued by the AACCC, NCISM/NCH
