		per the eligibility fixed for that round by paying complete fees again and filling fresh choices. R-1 admitted candidates withdraw their seats between 3 days prior to the commencement of Round 3 and till the date of publication of the 3rd Round final result (excluding the final result date), will become ineligible for AACCC-UG counseling. R-1 admitted candidates who withdraw their seats from the date of announcement of the 3rd Round final result will be ineligible for further Ayush - UG counseling. (Central/State/UT)
If not	Willing to participate in the next Rounds of AACCC-UG counseling	Candidates can participate in subsequent rounds as per the Eligibility fixed for that round by Filling fresh choices.

NOTE

- All candidates are advised to ensure that admission process made by the allotted college through online mode only by generating the “**Provisional Admission Letter**” from the AACCC UG portal. Any **admission made through offline mode shall be treated as null & void.**
- All participating institutes are instructed to facilitate the **admission/reporting of students even on holidays, if necessary.**
