INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS FOR COUNSELLING & ADMISSION TO M.D. (HOM.) IN MATERIA MEDICA FOR THE YEAR 2024-25

Odisha Joint Entrance Examination (OJEE) Committee, as the State Counselling Authority, will conduct counselling for admission to State Quota Seats of M.D. (Hom.) course in Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar, Odisha. In addition, as per the new guidelines of the Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India, AACCC will conduct counselling for admission against All India Quota (AIQ) seat in M.D. (Hom.) course in Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar, Odisha.

NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR INDIAN SYSTEM OF MEDICINE & NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR HOMEOPATHY, NEW DELHI

A. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Candidates interested to participate in the M.D. (Hom.) counselling must have qualified in the AIAPGET - 2024 with a valid rank.
 - (In order to be eligible for admission to M.D. (Hom.) course for this academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50^{th} percentile in the 'AIAPGET 2024 for the M.D. (Hom.) course' held for the said academic year :

Provided that in respect of-

- (a) Candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at the 40th percentile;
- (b) Candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile in the case of the General category and 40th percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.) The PwD should be as per the guidelines issued by NCH (available on Counselling website (www.aaccc.gov.in).
- For State Quota seats, the parents of the candidate must be permanent natives of Odisha. Every candidate must produce Resident / Nativity certificate (Form No.-III, See Rule-3 of Govt. of Odisha) during certificate verification.

In respect of persons with disability as specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum qualifying marks in the said qualifying examination as follows: a) shall be 45% in the case of the general category. b) 40% in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

- 3. Candidates must possess BHMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery) of not less than 5&1/2 years duration including one year compulsory internship / Degree or Provisional Degree certificate recognized as per the provision of HCC 1973 / NCH 2020 Act. and possesses permanent / provisional registration certificate / License issued by the CCH / NCH / State Board and must have completed a satisfactorily one-year compulsory rotating internship by 31st July 2024 as per the NCH notification for the academic year 2024-25 only.
- 4. Counselling will be conducted by the OJEE based on the applicable rules, regulations, reservation policy and other criteria specified by the Govt. of Odisha / NCH.

B. STEP- BY-STEP PROCEDURE OF COUNSELLING

Step – 1: All the candidates, who are interested to take part in the M.D. (Hom.) Counselling-cum-Admission process and who satisfies the above mentioned eligibility criteria, must register online in the website of OJEE i.e.www.ojee.nic.in by creating their own Username and Password by paying registration fees of Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable) through online mode at user login portal.

Only registered candidates will be considered for allotment / admission. As there is only one subject and one college, there is no provision of choice filling and choice locking.

Step – 2: The candidates, who get provisional allotment in the first round, have to deposit, as admission fee, an amount of Rs.12,420/- (excluding hostel fees) online in the candidate's login portal. Candidates have to pay the differential amount if any during admission at Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar.

Step – 3: The candidates, who get provisional allotment, have to report at OJEE Cell Gandamunda Bhubaneswar, Odisha / Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneswar as per the schedule date and time for document verification and provisional admission. List of Documents required to be verified during document verification is mentioned at Section – C. In case the candidate does not report to OJEE Cell, Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar, Odisha / Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Unit – III, Kharvel Nagar, Bhubaneswar for verification of documents and provisional admission, the allotted seat will be cancelled and the candidate may participate in subsequent round provided vacancy exists.

C. <u>LIST OF DOCUMENTS</u>

Candidates must bring the following original certificates / documents during reporting at OJEE Cell, Gandamunda / Dr. A. C. Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Unit – III, Kharvel Nagar, Bhubaneswar for document verification and provisional admission. Along with original set, one set photocopy must be produced during document verification.

- i) Admit Card of the AIAPGET 2024.
- ii) Rank card of the AIAPGET 2024.
- iii) Provisional Allotment letter of OJEE.
- iv) Medical Fitness Certificate.
- v) Board of Secondary Education Certificate or equivalent certificate.
- vi) Pass Certificate and Mark sheet of +2 Science or equivalent examination certificates.
- vii) B.H.M.S. certificate.
- viii) Mark sheet of Final B.H.M.S.
- ix) College / School leaving certificate
- x) Internship Training completion Certificate.
- xi) Nativity/Resident certificate of Odisha (Form–III, See Rule-3 of Govt. of Odisha.
- xii) SC/ST Certificate by birth issued by competent authority, Government of Odisha (See Rule-8(I)) (if applicable).
- xiii) License for practice of Homoeopathic Medicine issued by State Board of Homoeopathic Medicine or by Central Council of Homoeopathy along with updated renewal.
- xiv) "No Objection Certificate from the employer in case of in-service candidates.

xv) EWS Certificate issued by competent authority (if applicable) for 2024-25 financial year will only be accepted.

N.B. For availing admission under any types of quota, one should possess Nativity/Resident Certificate of Odisha and relevant Quota Certificate. Inability to produce the relevant documents during the period of document verification will lead to cancellation of the allotted seat under that claimed quota.

D. RESERVATIONS

1. State Quota Seats

The reservation policy of the Government of Odisha will be followed for selection. The reservations for different categories shall be as follows:

Scheduled Tribe (ST) 12%, Scheduled Caste (SC) 8%, Physically Challenged (PC) 5%, Ex-Servicemen (ES) 3%, Green Card Holders (GC) 5% and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) (10 %), wherever applicable.

Note:

- i. The ST/SC candidates must produce caste certificates from Odisha State only to get the privilege of reservation in the category in Odisha. (Vide Gol letter No. BC/16014/1/82 /SC & BCD/ Dated 22.02.1985) and they must be permanent natives of Odisha.
- ii. Candidates who wish to claim seats under Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) category have to mention the same during registration and have to produce valid EWS Certificates as per relevant Government notification.
- iii. If sufficient number of candidates are not available in any Reserved category, the vacant seats of the category will merge with that in the Un-reserved category. This will be done following proper procedure as per the Government guidelines.
- iv. One seat is reserved for In-service candidates, for which candidates must have completed 5 years of Regular Service and must be eligible as per the eligibility criteria mentioned above. Candidate must obtain No Objection Certificate from competent authority and deposit during counseling/ admission.

v. In case of non-availability of In-service candidate of General category, the seat will be filled up by taking the eligible fresh candidate of General category.

E. PROCEDURE FOR ONLINE ALLOTMENT

FIRST ROUND OF ALLOTMENT

- 1. In the first round, all registered candidates are provisionally allotted seats basing on their merit (AIPGET-2024 Rank). Reservations shall be considered as per candidate's declaration during registration.
- 2. After provisional allotment, these candidates have to deposit an amount of Rs.12,420/- (excluding hostel fees) online in the candidate's login portal as admission fee and report at OJEE Cell / Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Unit-III, Bhubaneswar for document verification and provisional admission. Detail document required are listed in Section C: List of Documents.
- 3. Candidates, who have paid the admission fees, and successfully get their documents verified, are considered for provisional admission as per their allotted category.
- 4. Candidates, who do not complete the steps as defined in (2) above, are disqualified and will not be considered for admission process.
- 5. Candidates who fail to produce relevant documents for their category they have claimed, will be disqualified of their temporary allotment and will be considered as general candidate in the subsequent round of allotment and the candidate have to fill choice fresh in 2nd round provided as vacancy exists.

WITHDRAWAL

Any candidate, who, for any reason, wants to withdraw from the process or wants to resign from the allotted seat, can do so within the stipulated date for 'withdrawal' as notified in the schedule.

SECOND ROUND COUNSELLING*

- 1. This round will start with registration for candidates not registered earlier.
- 2. Candidates who have not allotted any seat in 1st round, candidate allotted a seat but not reported have to fill choices fresh to be considered for the 2nd round allotment process.
- 3. Candidates, who do not make online fee payment and / or do not comply with the online document verification process after first round allotment, will be treated as not reported case.
- 4. Candidates, who get fresh allotment in this round, must make online fee payment and complete the reporting process by reporting at OJEE cell / Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Unit-III, Bhubaneswar and complete document verification process as explained before.

SPOT ADMISSION

If any vacancy arises after reporting of candidates at Dr. Abhin Chandra Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Unit-III, Bhubaneswar, Spot Counseling will be conducted. Procedure and schedule for spot counseling will be notified later.
