Revised Notice For Physically Challenged (PC)/ PwBD Candidates wish to take part in the 85% State Quota MBBS/BDS counselling and Admission Process.

In suppression to our earlier notice no:344/OJEE, dated:22-07-2025, it is to inform that after due clarification and referring to the MCC notice for PwBD candidates, it is decided to form the medical board at SCB, MCH, Cuttack for evaluation of the disability condition as per NMC guideline 2025 for the convenience of all eligible PwBD candidates of the State. Accordingly, the State domicile **Physically Challenged (PC)/PwBD** Category Candidates having valid NEET(UG) – 2025 RANK and interested to take admission under **PC/PwBD** category in the courses of **MBBS/BDS** at Govt and Private colleges of the State under State Quota Seats are required to visit the Medical Board at SCB, MCH on scheduled date and time. They are not required to visit any of the 16 designated Medical Boards as specified by NMC public notice. However, those who have visited any of the 16 designated Medical Board, evaluated their disability condition and obtained the report they need not report at SCB, MCH, Cuttack again. The report so obtained by them will be considered.

In the current registration process the candidates are required to upload the Valid UDID card, issued by appropriate authority, Self-certified affidavits in the prescribed format and applicable Affidavits as per the NMC Notification. All allotted candidates have to produce their evaluated report during admission/ reporting at OJEE Cell Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar during schedule time.
