ODISHA JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (OJEE) - 2025

MODALITIES FOR STRAY VACANCY/SPOT COUNSELING OF MBBS/BDS COURSES

The Spot Counselling for admission to vacant seats of MBBS/BDS courses for the academic session 2025-26 is scheduled to be held at OJEE Office, Gandamunda, Bhubaneswar on 13.11.2025 and 14.11.2025.

The vacant seats available in different colleges will be notified in website (www.ojee.nic.in) along with the time schedule for reporting of candidates. Hence, those who are interested to participate in the spot counselling, have to report at the counselling venue as per the date and time mentioned against their rank/merit.

1. ELIGIBILITY:

All state merit listed MBBS/BDS candidates are eligible to participate in the Spot Round Counselling. However, candidates, who have taken admission in any Institute through All India Counselling by MCC at the end of 3rd Round/ Stray Vacancy or through OJEE Counselling at the end of 3rd Round (including upgradation), are not eligible to participate in the OJEE Spot Counselling (As per relevant orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court).

All must go through the **modalities and instruction for MBBS/BDS counselling 2025** available at OJEE website.

2. GUIDELINES:

- 1. Admission will be done strictly as per merit (State Rank/NEET All India Rank).
- 2. Physical presence of the candidate is a must for participating in the spot counselling and no authorization will be entertained.
- 3. Candidate willing to participate in this round of counselling should report at counselling hall at the schedule time as per his/her category/rank. Only one person (Guardian) will be allowed with the candidate to the counselling hall.
- 4. Candidates have to put their signature in an attendance sheet at the sitting hall.
- 5. Candidates coming after the schedule time, will be allotted a seat/college from the balance seats available at that point of time taking merit into consideration.
- 6. Provisional Admission will be done at the venue of spot counselling.
 - The candidates must come with all original and photo copies of testimonials like ID proof, HS / Birth certificate, +2 Mark Sheet, +2 Pass Certificate, other category certificates if applicable, Residential/Nativity Certificate (Domicile), CLC/Transfer Certificate etc, along with admission fees in shape of Bank Draft

drawn in favour of "OJEE", payable at Bhubaneswar, failing which no admission will be made and the seat will be allotted to next candidate in merit. NRI Candidates to carry all relevant original documents related to their claim of NRI along with above mentioned documents.

- 7. Candidates who take admission in any category in this round, will not be allowed for any further change.
- 8. Participation in spot counselling does not ensure admission. Seats are allotted only on merit and availability of vacancy. Once all the vacant seats are filled up, counselling will be declared closed.
- If any category seats remain vacant due to non-availability of the corresponding category candidates the category seats will be converted to General/Open category before the start of the General/Open category counselling.
- 10. Participation in spot counselling does not ensure admission. Seats will be allotted only on merit and availability of vacancy. Once all the vacant seats are filled up, counselling will be declared closed.

3. FEE STRUCTURE:

1. Fees to be deposited for Government Medical/Dental Colleges:

Rs. 37,950/- per annum

NB: Additional fees as prescribed by concerned Govt. Colleges may be collected at institutional level which may vary from institution to institution.

2. Fees to be deposited for Private Medical/Dental colleges:

The Fees to be deposited for MBBS course in Private Medical Colleges:

*Hi-Tech MCH Bhubaneswar - Rs.11,56,000/- per annum,

*Hi-Tech MCH Rourkela

- Rs.8,54,000/- per annum

*DRIEMS Institute of Health Sciences & Hospital - Rs.9,08,000/- per annum

*The Fees to be deposited for Private (Hi-Tech) Dental Colleges is Rs.3,00,000/- per annum.

*NRI candidates have to pay four times of the above fees in private colleges.

The admitted candidates have to deposit Rs.3,500/- towards University Registration fees during admission at their respective institutes.

THE SAME SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BE APPLICABLE.
