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BOMBAY ACT No. XXII OF 1949¹

[THE BOMBAY SEALS ACT, 1949.]

[This Act received the assent of the Governor on the 6th May 1949; assent was first published, in the *Bombay Government Gazette*, Part IV, on the 12th May 1949.]

An Act to provide for the alteration of seals prescribed in the Letters Patent of the High Court and certain enactments.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the alteration of seals prescribed in the Letters Patent of the High Court of Judicature for the Presidency of Bombay, bearing date the twenty-eighth day of December, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, and the Bombay Civil Courts Act, 1869 (XIV of 1869); It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) This Act may be called the Bombay Seals Act, 1949.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Provincial Government may, by notification in the *Official Gazette*, appoint.

2. Amendment of clause 6 of the Letters Patent of 28th December 1865.— In clause 6 of the Letters Patent of the High Court of Judicature for the Presidency of Bombay, bearing date the twenty-eighth day of December, One thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, for the words “Our Royal Arms” the words “the Asoka Capital Motif” shall be substituted.
