BOMBAY REGULATION No. II OF 1951.

[The Bombay Secondary School Certificate Examination Act (Application to Schhduled Areas) Regulation, 1951.]

[29th June 1951]

A Regulation for the application of the Bombay Secondary School Certificate Examination Act, 1948, to certain Scheduled Areas in the State of Bombay.

WHEREAS it is necessary to apply the provisions of the *Bombay Secondary School Bom XLIX of Certificate Examination Act, 1948, to certain Scheduled Areas in the State of Bombay 1948. for the peace and good Government of the said areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub- paragraph (2) of paragraph 5 of the Fifth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the Governor of Bombay is, hereby pleased, with the assent of the President, to make the following Regulation, namely:—

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Bombay Secondary School Certificate Short title, Examination Act (Application to Scheduled Areas) Regulation, 1951.

(2) It extends to the areas specified in the Schedule appended to this Regulation.

2. The Bombay Secondary School Certificate Examination Act, 1948 (hereinafter Application of XLIX of referred to as the said Act), shall subject to the modification specified in section 3, apply Bombay 1948. to the areas specified in the Schedule (hereinafter referred to as the said areas), and sections 1 to 33 of the said Act shall be deemed to be and to have been in force in the said areas with effect from the 7th day of October 1948 and section 34 with effect from the 8th day of November 1948.

3. In the application of the said Act to the said areas, sub-section (2) of section 1 Modification thereof shall be deleted.
