THE HYDERABAD PUBLIC LIBRARIES (REPEAL) ACT, 1961.]

[27th September 1961]

An Act to repeal the Hyderabad Public Libraries Act, 1955.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Hyderabad Public Libraries Act, 1955; It is hereby enacted in the Twelfth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Hyderabad Public Libraries (Repeal) Act, 1961. Short title
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by mincement notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

2. The Hyderabad Public Libraries Act, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the Repeal of Hyderabad said Act") is hereby repealed. 1955. Act III of 1955.

- With effect from the commencement of this Act,—
- (a) every Local Library Authority constituted under the said Act shall be be dissolved. deemed to have been dissolved and the members thereof shall vacate office;
- to consoli**dat-**(b) the Library Fund maintained by a Local Library Authority under section 13 ed Fund. and of the said Act shall be wound up and the balance standing to the credit of other properany such fund immediately before such commencement, shall be credited to the authority to Consolidated Fund of the State; and v e s t Collector.
- (c) all properties movable and immovable vested in any such Local Library Authority under the said Act shall without further assurance, vest in the Collector, and continue so to vest until the State Government otherwise directs.
