In pursuance of clause (3) of article 348 of the Constitution of India, the following translation in English of the Maharashtra (Supplementary) Appropriation Act, 2014 (Mah. Act III of 2014), is hereby published under the authority of the Governor.

MAHARASHTRA ACT No. III OF 2014.

(First published, after having received the assent of the Governor in the "Maharashtra Government Gazette", on the 3rd March 2014)

An Act to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 2014.

WHEREAS by virtue of article 204 of the Constitution of India, read with article 205 thereof, it is necessary to provide for the passing of an Appropriation Act for the appropriation of further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March, 2014; and for the purpose of authorising payment of the said sums; it is hereby enacted in the Sixty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Maharashtra (Supplementary) Short title. Appropriation Act, 2014.

Withdrawal of Rs. 13,70,85,34,000 out of the Consolidated

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (4) of the Schedule hereto annexed amounting in aggregate to the sum of one Fund of the State thousand three hundred seventy crores, eighty five lakhs, thirty four for the Financial thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come Year 2013-2014. in course of payment during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 2014, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the year ending on the thirty-first day of March 2014.
