An Act to disqualify certain aliens from being members and from voting at elections of members, of certain local authorities in the Presidency of Bombay.

WHEREAS, it is expedent that certain aliens should be disqualified from being members and from voting at elections of members, of certain local authorities in the Presidency of Bombay; It is hereby enacted as follows

- **1.** This Act may be called the ²[the Maharashtra Disqualification of AliensShort title. Act].
 - ³[1-A. This Act extends to the ⁴[Bombay area of the State of Maharashtra]. Definitions.
- **2.** In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,— $^{5}[(a)$ "alien" means
 - (i) a person who is ⁶[not a citizen of India], or
 - (*ii*) a person who, whether he is himself within the foregoing definition or not, represents an alien firm as defined in clause (*aa*) for the purpose of voting at an election of a member of any of the local authorities specified in the Schedule or for the purpose of membership of any of the said authorities;

 - (c) "member" includes a municipal councillor and a member of a body of trustees.

3. Save as hereinafter otherwise provided, no alien shall be qualified to be a fication of member any of the local authorities specified in the Schedule or to vote at any aliens. election of a member of any of the authorities.

- **4.** (1) If any person having become a member of any of the local authorities subsequent specified in the Schedule, subsequently becomes an alien his seat shall thereupon disqualifica- become vacant.
 - (2) Section 18 of the ¹City Bombay Municipal Act, 1888, shall be read and Bom. III of construed as if, after the word "aforesaid", the words "or under the Bombay 1888. Disqualification of Aliens Act, 1918", were inserted.
 - (3) Section 15, sub-section (3) of the ¹Bombay District Municipal Act, 1901 shall Bom. III of be read and construed as if, after the word "section" the word "or under the 1901. Bombay Disqualification of Aliens Act, 1918" were inserted.

Exemption.

5. The ²[³[State] Government] may, by notification in the ⁵[Official Gazette], exempt any person or class of person from the operation of this Act.

Modification of Schedule.

6. The ²[³[State] Government] may, by notification in the 5[Official Gazette], direct that the name of any of the local authorities specified in the Schedule shall be omitted therefrom, or that the name of any other local authority shall be entered therein and such direction, shall have effect accordingly.
