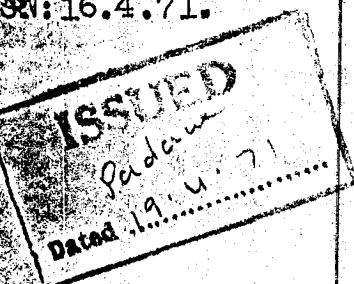

Accompaniment to Government Resolution, Law and
Judiciary Department No. 9750/C,
dated the 16th April 1971.

Appointment shall be made -

- (a) by promotion from among suitable class IV servants (i) who have studied upto S.S.C. and (ii) who have worked in the Library as a Library peon for at least 5 years or as a Shelf Attendant for at least 3 years;

or

- (b) by nomination.

2. To be eligible for appointment by nomination, a candidate must be not more than 28 years of age and must possess -

- (a) educational qualification upto S.S.C.,
(b) previous experience for not less than 5 years in the capacity of a peon or for not less than 3 years in the capacity of Library attendant or in a similar position,

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed upto 30 years in favour of candidates, who have served in a Law Library and have acquired sufficient experience.

3. A candidate appointed by nomination shall be required to pass an examination in Marathi within the period of two years and an examination in Hindi according to the prescribed rules unless he has already passed the said examinations or has been exempted from passing them under the said rules.
