CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1088/1896-(197)-II.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules for regulating recruitment to the post of the Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department, and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs (Recruitment) Rules, 1990.

2. Appointment to the post of the Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs, shall be made either—

(a) by selection of an officer from amongst the officers recommended by the High Court, who have held a judicial office not lower in rank than that of a District Judge, for at least five years, by deputation or by permanent transfer; or

(b) by promotion of an officer in the Law and Judiciary Department, who has held a post not lower in rank than that of Joint Secretary to Government in any Legal Section thereof, for at least five years; or

(c) on contract basis of a person who—

(i) has practised as an advocate for at least ten years; and

(ii) who is not less than 45 years of age.

3. A person appointed to the post under these rules, whether by transfer or promotion or on contract basis, shall be required to pass examinations in Hindi and Marathi according to the rules made in that behalf, unless he has already passed or has been exempted from passing those examinations.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. RTR. 1091/244(27)-II.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs (Recruitment) Rules, 1990, namely :—

1. These rules may be called the Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs (Recruitment) (Amendment) Rules, 1991.

2. For rule 2 of the Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs Recruitment Rules, 1990, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :—

"2. Appointment to the post of Secretary to the Government of Maharashtra, Law and Judiciary Department and Remembrancer of Legal Affairs, shall be made,—

(a) by selection of a person from amongst those who are holding or have held for at least five years a judicial office not lower in rank than that of a District Judge; or

(b) by promotion of an officer in the Law and Judiciary Department, who has held a post not lower in rank than that of Joint Secretary to Government in any legal section thereof, for at least five years; or

(c) on contract basis of a person who,—

(a) is practising or has practised as an Advocate for at least ten years; and

(b) who is not less than forty-five years of age.

Explanation.—For the purpose of this rule,—

(a) the expression "District Judge" means only that judicial officer who is or had been brought on the cadre of District Judge;

(b) in computing the period during which a person is practising or has practised as an Advocate, there shall be included any period during which the person has held a judicial office not below the rank of District Judge, after he became an Advocate."
