Subject : General revision of storage charges from April 01, 2025.

Please refer to subject cited.

It is informed that as HSWC is following the pattern of CWC with regard to revision of storage charges for various commodities with some modifications, with the approval of Board of Directors of the corporation. Since the Central Warehousing Corporation has revised its general tariff of storage charges w.e.f. 01.4.2025 for various commodities by adopting the new rating of warehouses. As such, HSWC has also revised the storage charges of various commodities w.e.f. 01.4.2025, on the pattern of CWC both under Reservations and General Warehousing with some modifications in CWC storage Tariff in anticipation of BOD approval. If any new commodity is received in the warehouses, the proposal for the same may be sent to Head Office for fixation of storage tariff accordingly.

The tariff of wheat for FCI is case of reservation (guaranteed storage for a minimum period of one year or more, the tariff decided by Ministry of CA, f & PD, Department of Food & Public Distribution, Govt. of India will be applicable for the FY 2025-26.

The revised tariff of storage charges w.e.f. 1.4.2025 is given below:

2. AREA RATES:

The Area Basis Tariff have been revised and in case the tariff implemented before revision of tariff is more than the revised tariff, the same are continued as per existing tariff as per CWC tariff.

The area rates per sq. feet per month when storage space is provided on 'Area Basis' are as under:

a) ACC Sheet Godowns (with truss)

- Gross area basis : Rs. 15.99/- per sq. feet/pm plus advalorem charges.
- Net area basis : Rs. 24.05/- per sq. feet/pm plus advalorem charges.

b) Galvalume sheet roofing godowns without truss

- Gross area basis : Rs. 17.59/- per sq. feet/pm plus advalorem charges.
- Net area basis : Rs. 24.63/- per sq. feet /pm plus advalorem charges

c) Rates for fumigable stock stored on area basis

- Gross area basis : Rs. 18.95/- per sq. feet/pm plus advalorem charges.
- Net area basis : Rs. 25.17/- per sq. feet/pm plus advalorem charges.

Note: There will be no rebate on storage charges on area basis. Commodities deposited in bulk, agricultural implements, iron and steel materials i.e. pipes, sheets etc. paper and other such goods which do not have a uniform package or received without packing shall be accepted for storage on area basis.

The Storage Tariff for open area will be 60% of covered area rate in General Warehousing Segment & Export warehouse attached to CFS/ICD 75% of covered area rate for bonded Warehouse.

3. STORAGE OF INDUSTRIAL GOODS:

For storage of industrial goods, the warehouses are divided into four categories, i.e., Premium, Elite, Super & Normal.

The centers to be placed in these categories are also indicated below:

The premium to be charged for storage of Industrial Goods for different categories of warehouses will be as follows:-

Sr. No.	Category of warehouse	Premium to be charged over the base rates
1	Normal	General tariff + 0%
2	Super	General tariff + 25%
3	Elite	General tariff + 50%
4	Premium	General tariff + 100%

4. No rebate shall be allowed for Agriculture goods and other Notified Commodities for Private depositors without approval of Corporate Office.
5. As per the current billing logic in case of General Basis monthly billing depositors, bills shall be generated WHR wise which has completed 30 days storage as per this office circular dated 02.07.2020. Due to this, logic, stock received on 28th of any month shall be billed after completion of 30 days i.e. 27th of next month. However, to streamline the process billing logic has been revised and bills shall be generated in the end of same month, on which stock is received. For example, if stock is received on 28th April, then its billing should be done in billing month of April itself for no. of days stored in that month i.e., for 03 days in this case and for the calculation of day wise tariff, no. of days to be stored divided by 30days (Month is considered 30 days irrespective of calendar month) multiplied with monthly tariff may be kept.
6. In case of last billing for part month, per day tariff may be calculated by dividing no. of days by 30 as month. For example, if reservation is valid till 18th August 2025, then in last bill, per day tariff may be calculated as No. of days for utilization (18)/30 irrespective of calendar month.
7. The categorization/grouping of warehouses for industrial tariff is subject to review at any time depending upon the demand and availability of storage space and in the overall business interest of the Corporation. In case, it is felt by the District Manager that any Warehouse needs to be re-categorized for industrial tariff, he may recommend the same to the Head Office with full justification.
8. Cooperative institutions will be entitled to 10% statutory rebate and the bonafide farmers of Haryana will enjoy the rebate of 30% on Rabi produce and 50% on Kharif produce on the general tariff, subject to a ceiling of 50 MT individually for each crop for agriculture goods only. No rebate for Central Pool stocks including paddy, wheat, Bajra or rice is admissible.
9. Fumigable stock e.g. Foodgrains, pulses, seeds etc. Should invariably be stored on bag basis only and not on area basis except wherever circumstances warrant with the prior approval of Corporate Office.
10. The storage charges on FCI stocks for guaranteed utilization of warehouse space will be at par with the rates payable to Central Warehousing Corporation by FCI.
11. The warehouseman shall ensure that storage charges as per general tariff are realized in full from depositors including Central/State agencies viz. IFFCO, KRIBHCO, NFL, NAFED, FSD, HAFED, HAIC, CONFED etc. before release of goods, stored in the warehouse, to the depositor.
12. In case the Corporation is having special arrangement or allotted space on dedicated basis, the provisions agreed may continue till expiry of the agreement. However, if the depositor wants to extend/renew the agreement on dedicated warehousing, then in such a situation, further extension may be considered on the basis of revised tariff as well as model agreement already circulated or the charges depositor is paying earlier as per terms including escalation agreed upon, whichever is higher.
13. In case there is a provision in the agreement that the rate will be charged as per tariff as and when revised by the corporation, in such cases the revised rate is applicable.
14. FCI/SCSC Gunny Bales:- Separate bills to be generated for food grain and gunny bales stored within reserved space. The bills for food grain stored will not attract GST, however, bills for storage of gunny bales in reserved space will attract GST.
For example; at any centre FCI/SCSC has reservation of 5000 MT and out of this 5000 MT capacity FCI stored 100 MT of gunny bales and 4900 MT of food-grain, in this scenario the separate bills will be raised for 4900 MT food-grain on reservation rates (without GST) and for 100 MT gunny bales on reservation rates (with applicable GST).
This shall be applicable only where minimum guarantee reservation period is of 01 year.
15. Tariff with regard to FCI on guarantee basis is regulated by the Ministry, based on recommendations of Chief Advisor Cost (CAC), Ministry of Finance and the same shall be circulated as and when revised.
16. Goods and service Tax/any other Tax as levied by the Central/State Govt. or local bodies, if any, will be charged extra if applicable, in addition to storage/insurance charges etc.

In case, any commodity has been omitted, the same may be brought into the notice of this office for taking necessary action.

17. No credit facility is allowed to State procuring agencies. However, the concessional rate of storage charges at par with FCI, shall be applicable for State procuring agencies viz. FSD, HAFED, HAIC, & CONFED for the storage of Central Pool Stock only, in case storage space is utilized by them on guarantee utilization basis for minimum one year and an undertaking is given by them to clear the arrears in the event of rate revision by FCI with retrospective effect in future. However, if the storage space is utilized by the State procuring agencies and FCI on actual utilization basis, the general tariff will be charged.

18. To ensure optimum utilization of capacity, minimum stack height shall be maintained as under:

- i) ACC Sheet Godowns (with truss): 15 ft.
- ii) Galvalume Sheet Godowns (without truss): 18-20 ft.

19. Where the storage charges are exclusive of insurance/indemnification charges and where tariff is realized on area basis, insurance charges will be realized extra @ 5 paise per 100 rupee value of stocks per month or part thereof. The cases where depositor has got his stocks insured at his risk & cost, will be decided by Head Office for not realizing insurance charges.

It is further intimated that as earlier instructions issued vide letter No. HSWC/BA-2/Business/2024/17430-441 dated 03.07.2024 that standard weight shall be calculated as per old pattern i.e. tariff for the financial year 2021-22 till the finalization of case by CWC. In this regard it is further directed that tariff of Mustard/Taramira is increased by 6 % in compensation of revision of Bag equivalent i.e. 53 % enhanced from last year. Hence, the standard bag of Mustard shall be enhanced to 0.67 from 0.44 as per standard weight for the year 2021-22.

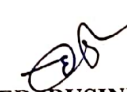
