MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

1. Name of the Society

1.1 The name of the Society shall be the National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities (Divyangian).

2. The registered office of the Society shall be situated at Dehradun and at present is at the following address:

3. **Jurisdiction**: The Society will have an All India Jurisdiction to work towards achieving its objectives.

4. Aims and objectives of the society:

The aims and objectives for which this society is established are as under:

- (i) To conduct, sponsor, co-ordinate or subsidize research into all aspects of the education and rehabilitation of Persons with Visual Disabilities.
- (ii) To undertake or sponsor the training of trainees and Teachers, Clinical & Rehabilitation Psychology, Social Workers, Employment Officers, Psychologists, Vocational Counselors and such other personnel as may be deemed necessary by promoting the Education, Training and Rehabilitation of Persons with Visual Disabilities.
- (iii) To distribute or promote or subsidize the manufacture of prototypes products and distribution of any or all aids designed to promote any aspects of the education, rehabilitation or therapy of Persons with Visual Disabilities.
- (vi) To undertake Clinical, Educational, Academic, skilling & other Rehabilitation services for Persons with Visual Disabilities.

4.1 For the realization of its objectives, the institute: -

- (i) To develop appropriate models of care for persons with Visual Disabilities, which will have special emphasis care both in rural and urban areas:
- (ii) To acquire relevant data as to the nature of the challenges and on the felt needs of the community in the care of Persons with Visual Disabilities and to identify, conduct and coordinate research in these areas:
- (iii) To develop appropriate models of education, training and rehabilitation and to impart training to the key personnel involved in the care and training of persons with Visual Disabilities which will include parents, teachers and all levels of health, education and rehabilitation personnel: -
- (iv) To undertake extension programmes and to monitor and evaluate them.
- (v) To develop appropriate educational material and carry out programmes of public education and mass communication.
- (vi) To assist and advise voluntary agencies in various programmes and initiating and coordinating activities in the community and
- (vii) To develop appropriate programmes for rehabilitation of persons with Visual Disabilities including institutional programmes and services in linkage with existing medical, educational & rehabilitation services.
- (viii) To undertake services and outreach programmes for persons with visual disabilities.
