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1. Important Admission Notice

Admissions being conducted in 2026 pertain only to the **Academic Session 2025–26**.

Only the following candidates are eligible to apply:

- Candidates who have already passed the qualifying Master’s degree in the relevant discipline.
- Candidates who completed their qualifying degree in 2025 or earlier, and whose final results have already been declared, are eligible to apply, provided they possess their final marksheets and degree or provisional degree certificates at the time of application. Candidates belonging to the 2024–2026 academic session or subsequent sessions are technically not eligible, as the present admission cycle is for the 2025–2027 session. Applicants who are completing or are expected to complete their Master’s degree in 2026 would face an overlap between their Master’s programme and the M.Phil. programme during the academic year 2026. Technically, both the Master’s degree and the M.Phil. programme cannot be treated as running simultaneously in the same academic session.

The following candidates are not eligible:

- Candidates currently appearing in final examinations.
- Candidates whose results are awaited.
- Candidates without final qualifying documents.

Applications submitted by ineligible candidates may be rejected at any stage.

2. About the Department

Reservation applies as per Government of India norms.

Fees may be paid in quarterly instalments.

4. Eligibility Criteria

- Master's degree in Psychology
- Minimum 55 percent marks
- SC/ST candidates, 50 percent marks
- Entrance Test plus Interview
- Full-time, on-campus programme

5. Application Options and Fee Rules

Applicants must carefully choose one of the following options:

- Option 1, M.Phil. Clinical Psychology only
- Option 2, M.Phil. Rehabilitation Psychology only
- Option 3, Both Programmes

Common Entrance Examination

There shall be one common entrance examination.

Selection shall be based on:

- Entrance merit
- Eligibility criteria
- Reservation policy
- Programme option chosen

Fee Rule for Applying in Both Programmes

Separate fee must be paid for each programme.

Example:

If the entrance fee is ₹5,000 per programme, a candidate applying for both programmes must pay ₹10,000.

Important Clarification

If a candidate selects both programmes but pays fee only for one programme, the application shall be treated only for that programme.

Even if the candidate falls within merit for the other programme, consideration shall not be given.

The application will automatically be treated as application for a single programme only.

6. Admission Procedure

Admission process shall include:

1. Online application submission
2. Payment of prescribed fee
3. Entrance examination
4. Interview
5. Merit preparation
6. Verification of original documents
7. Application of reservation policy
8. Final admission

Submission of application does not guarantee admission.

Qualifying the entrance examination alone does not guarantee admission.

9. Entrance Examination Instructions

Applicants should not wait for formal admit card.

Admit card shall be issued at the examination venue on the day of examination.

Candidates must bring:

- Proof of application submission
- Proof of fee payment
- Valid photo identification

The examination shall be conducted under video recording.

10. Vacant Seats Policy

If seats remain vacant:

- Institute may notify vacant seats.
- Consideration may be made from existing applicants only.
- Existing merit and reservation rules shall apply.
- Fresh applications may not be invited unless separately notified.

11. Attendance, Leave and Academic Continuity

Requirement	Rule
Minimum Attendance	80 percent
Casual Leave	15 days
Continuous Training	Mandatory
Completion Period	As per RCI norms

Failure to meet academic or clinical requirements may result in examination ineligibility.

12. Hostel and Campus Facilities

Hostel accommodation is reserved for persons with disabilities, subject to availability.

Other students shall make their own residential arrangements.

Facilities include:

- Clinical training rooms
- Psychological testing facilities
- Therapy rooms

- ICT-enabled classrooms
- Barrier-free campus
- Outpatient clinical services

13. Mandatory Undertakings at Admission

Admitted students shall submit:

1. Anti-Ragging Undertaking
2. Undertaking regarding employment (NOC and study leave if applicable) and full-time training
3. Undertaking regarding non-enrolment in another regular course
4. Undertaking for compliance with institute rules
5. Declaration regarding authenticity of information

False declarations may result in cancellation of admission.

14. Discipline and Professional Conduct

Students shall comply with:
